



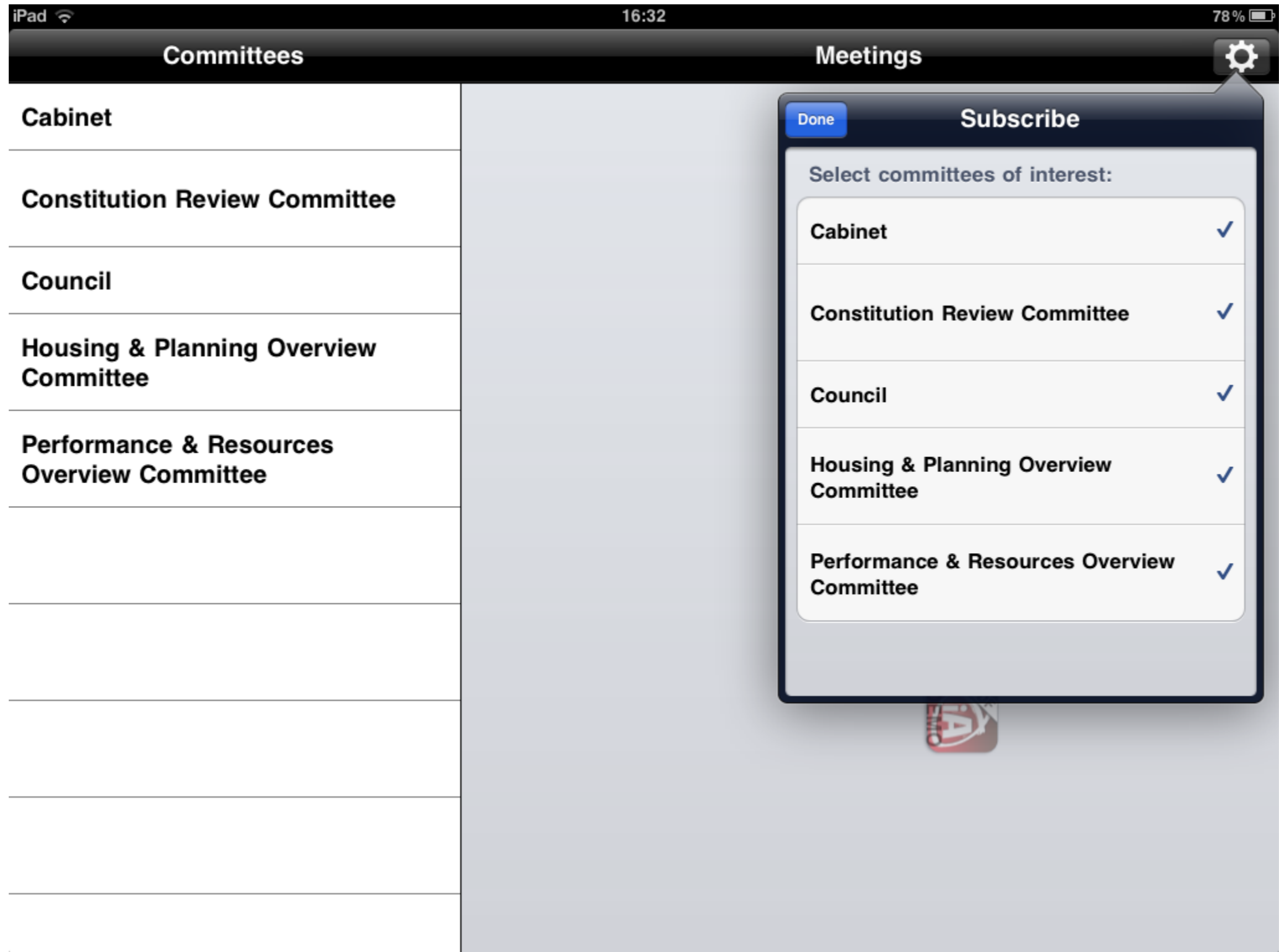

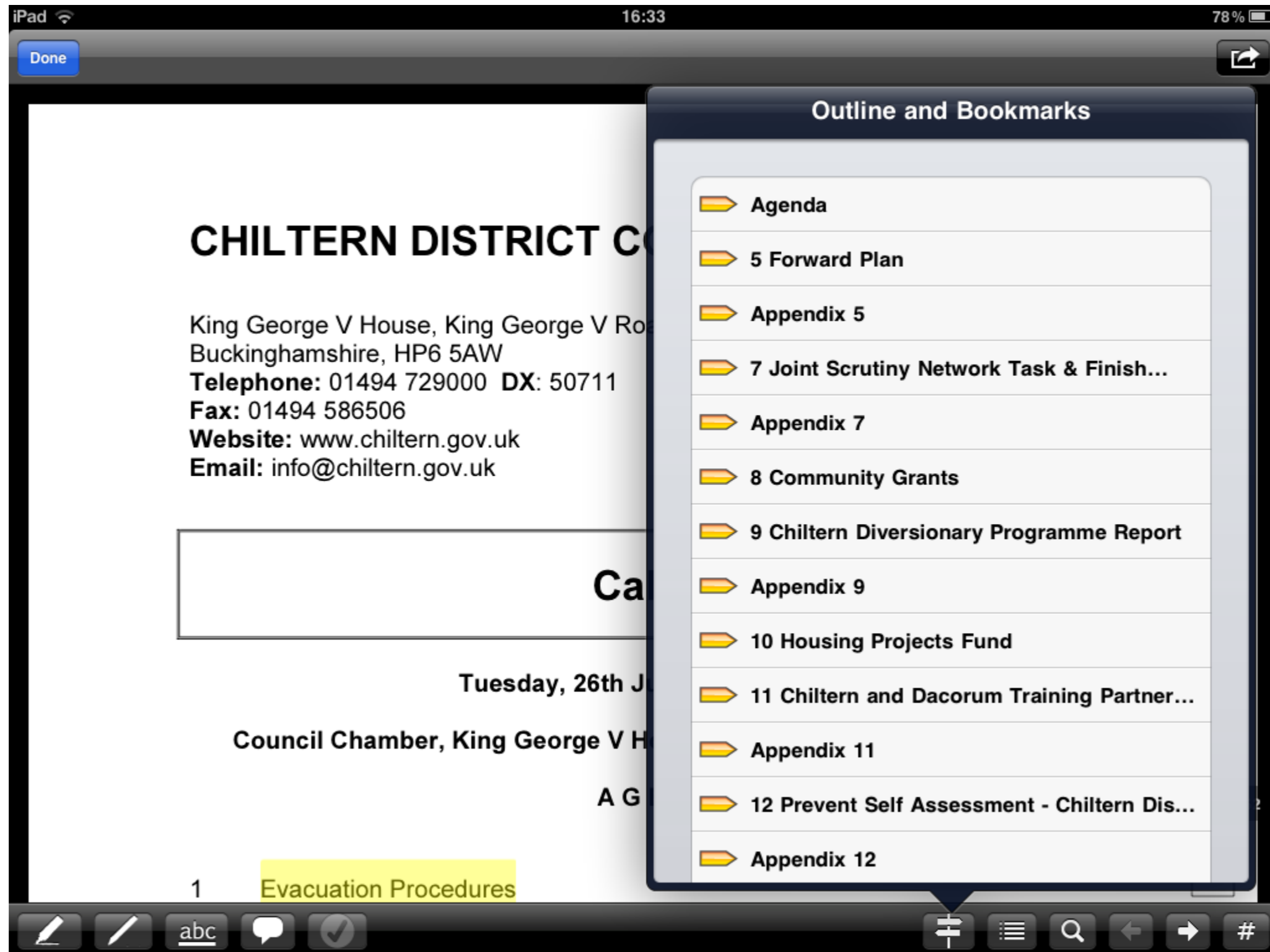



Background

- 1 This year the Community Grant Scheme attracted 54 applications, which have been assessed following the agreed criteria involving; Officer scoring, Member consultation, and final approval by the Head of Health and Housing in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Young People, Leisure, Community and Communication.
- 2 The quality of applications was high standard with many being further into the area's Revitalisation Group process.

- 3 The applications amounted to a total request of £87,309 against an available Grant Fund of £33,646.
- 4 The available funds were insufficient to fully award each of the projects' requested level of grant aid.
- 5 Members supported the giving of bigger percentage grants to those projects which most closely meet the Council's criteria. It was therefore recommended by Members that grants which were closely aligned to the Council's policies received a higher award on the following scale.

 - 70 points = 35% of the amount applied for
 - 80 points = 60% of the amount applied for
 - 90 points = 75% of the amount applied for
