Key agenda items included the Integrated Care System (ICS) Workforce Strategy; NWL Winter Resilience Plans; NWL Elective Orthopaedic Centre update and an ICS Update. Among other points raised, Harrow suggested that NWL NHS engages with Harrow's Estates team in relation to the work on the NWL NHS Estates Strategy to ensure alignment on outputs and resident needs. Harrow also requested for monitoring reports to be brought back to the committee for the new Elective Orthopaedic Centre against set targets for improved productivity, quality, and efficiency.</p> <p>The next JHOSC meeting is on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2024.</p> <p>There are regular update reports on the JHOSC to Harrow's Health and Social Care Scrutiny Sub-Committee so that there is a formal feedback loop between regional and local health scrutiny.
