I am the Team Leader at Harrow Council for Environmental Protection.

I am raising an objection, subject to your answers, to your application for a TEN at Unit 2 Brember Road on the grounds of Public Nuisance.

I am very concerned that access to the unit is through residential streets and wish to know what mitigation you have in place to prevent cars leaving the area through these streets in a manner that will not intrude upon residents that early in the morning.

Whilst I have seen your answers to a similar question from the police licencing team, I am still concerned that you will not be able to adequately control patrons behaviour in the surrounding streets as they leave the area.

Hello Farima,

Hope you had a good weekend. I have sent the following response to the Environmental health department.

Thank you for your email and for bringing your concerns to my attention.

I understand the importance of ensuring that our event at Unit 2 Brember Road does not intrude upon residents, particularly during the early hours. To address your concerns, i have put the following measures in place:

1. Patron education in advance will aid all the measures I have in place. Social media and WhatsApp enables me to have direct contact with and built a good relationship with patrons attending my event. I will communicate with patrons in advance and upon arrival, emphasizing the importance of being considerate to the local community as they arrive and leave the venue. Staff will be stationed at key points to guide drivers appropriately.

2. I have a staggered exit strategy in place to prevent congestion and reduce noise, I will implement a staggered exit strategy where patrons leave the premises in small, controlled groups over a longer period. This will help minimize the impact on surrounding areas.
3. The security team will enforce a 'quiet zone' policy in the immediate vicinity of the venue. Patrons will be reminded to respect the neighborhood and avoid any noisy behavior as they depart.
4. My engagement with Local Authorities is important to me. I will continue to liaise closely with the local police licensing team and other relevant authorities to ensure compliance with all regulations and to address any issues that arise promptly.

We are neighbours to a very large capacity venue in the same location which host events with a lot more patrons than we have stated. If they can manage such large events (at times traditional events with elephant walking through residential streets with the guests) and there are no stipulations against their events intruding upon neighbours, you can be assured with all the measures I have put in place, we will not be intruding on the local residents.

I hope these measures adequately address your concerns and demonstrate our commitment to minimizing any potential disturbance to local residents. We have gone over the top to ensure that there is the minimum of disturbance to nearby residents and to ensure a successful and respectful event. As you have indicated that you have seen the measures we put forward to the police, we are confident that we will achieve the licensing objectives.

Thank you for your correspondence.

Please note that the Environmental Health department has submitted a representation on the grounds of Public Nuisance. They do not believe the venue is suited to events up to 4am, and whilst it is in an industrial unit, the only access to the location is through residential streets.

They have stated the following:

*"Hence can you kindly confirm what noise stipulations are there to be and what actions are the organisers planning to take to mitigate noise revellers leaving the area through the residential streets will undoubtedly cause."*
