Question	Following on from our lengthy diatribes on the dangerous speeding on our road it is now quite clear that the Council are reticent to do anything about it unless/until a serious incident occurs – and similarly our repeated requests for a 20mph arrangement have also been repeatedly rejected: Accordingly whilst we understand that a 20mph ZONE 'should be self-enforcing' (eg. via "vertical displacement cushions" aka 'speed humps' etc) are there any good reasons why a 20mph LIMIT could just not be deployed instead (as in evidence in many other London Boroughs, and yet without the 'humps')?
