Pursuant to Regulation 5(4) and (5) of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 notice is hereby given that the Cabinet will need to meet in private, as previously advised by the April 2021 Key Decision Schedule, to take a Key Decision at its meeting due to be held virtually on Thursday 29 April 2021 at 6.30pm.

The Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has agreed that the decision relating to the item, '**Leisure Centre Contract – Future Delivery Options**', is urgent for the reasons set out below and should therefore not be subject to the Call-In Procedure.
