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## GUIDANCE NOTE FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ATTENDING THE DEVELOPMENT CONTROL COMMITTEE

## Order of Committee Business

It is the usual practice for the Committee to bring forward, to the early part of the meeting, those planning applications where notice has been given that objectors wish to speak, or where members of the public have come to hear the debate.

You will find a slip of paper on your seat for you to indicate which item you have come for. This should be handed to the Committee Administrator prior to the start of the meeting.

Although the Committee will try to deal with the application which you are interested in as soon as possible, often the agendas are quite long and the Committee may want to raise questions of officers and enter into detailed discussion over particular cases. This means that you may have to wait some time. The Committee normally adjourns around 9.00 pm for a short refreshment break for Members.

## Rights of Objectors/Applicants to Speak at Development Control Committees

Please note that objectors may only speak when they have given 24 hours notice. In summary, where a planning application is recommended for grant by the Chief Planning Officer, a representative of the objectors may address the Committee for up to 3 minutes.
Where an objector speaks, the applicant has a right of reply.
Planning Services advises neighbouring residents and applicants of this procedure.
The Development Control Committee is a formal quasi-judicial body of the Council with responsibility for determining applications, hence the need to apply rules governing the rights of public to speak. Full details of this procedure are also set out in the "Guide for Members of the Public Attending the Development Control Committee" which is available in both the Environmental Information Centre and First Floor Reception or by contacting the Committee Administrator (tel 0208424 1269). This guide also provides useful information for Members of the public wishing to present petitions, deputations or ask public questions, and the rules governing these procedures at the Development Control Committee.

## Addendum Sheet

In addition to this agenda, an Addendum Sheet is produced on the day of the meeting. This updates the Committee on any additional information received since the formal agenda was published and also identifies any applications which have been withdrawn by applicants or which officers are recommending for deferral. Copies of the Addendum are available for the public in the Committee Room from 6.30 pm onwards.

## Decisions taken by the Development Control Committee

## Set out below are the types of decisions commonly taken by this Committee

## Refuse permission:

Where a proposal does not comply with the Council's (or national) policies or guidance and the proposal is considered unacceptable, the Committee may refuse planning permission. The applicant can appeal to the Secretary of State against such a decision. Where the Committee refuse permission contrary to the officer recommendation, clear reasons will be specified by the Committee at the meeting.

## Grant permission as recommended:

Where a proposal complies with the Council's (or national) policies or guidance and the proposal is considered acceptable, the Committee may grant permission. Conditions are normally imposed.

## Minded to grant permission contrary to officer's recommendation:

On occasions, the Committee may consider the proposal put before them is acceptable, notwithstanding an officer recommendation of refusal. In this event, the application will be deferred and brought back to a subsequent meeting. Renotification will be carried out to advise that the Committee is minded to grant the application.

## Defer for a site visit:

If the Committee decides that it can better consider an application after visiting the site and seeing the likely impact of a proposal for themselves, the application may be deferred until the next meeting, for an organised Member site visit to take place.

## Defer for further information/to seek amendments:

If the Committee considers that it does not have sufficent information to make a decision, or if it wishes to seek amendments to a proposal, the application may be deferred to a subsequent meeting.

## Grant permission subject to a legal agreement:

Sometimes requirements need to be attached to a planning permission which cannot be dealt with satisfactorily by conditions. The Committee therefore may grant permission subject to a legal agreement being entered into by the Council and the Applicant/Land owner to ensure these additional requirements are met.
(Important Note: This is intended to be a general guide to help the public understand the Development Control Committee procedures. It is not an authoritative statement of the law. Also, the Committee may, on occasion, vary procedures).

## Planning application within Wealdstone - <br> Bentley House Hotel, 15-21 Headstone Drive, Wealdstone, Harrow : <br> Reference from the Wealdstone Regeneration Advisory Panel Meeting held on 30 <br> November 2004

1. Following their declarations of interest in relation to this item, which related to planning permission for Bentley House Hotel, 15-21 Headstone Drive, Wealdstone, the Chair indicated her agreement to Councillors Marilyn Ashton and Billson remaining in the meeting whilst it was discussed.
2. The Chair advised that the application was seeking a change of use for the premises and she understood that there were a number of interested parties that wished to relocate to the site. The information in the application proposed that the ground and first floors of the premises be converted back to offices. A Member added that it was to be welcomed that an organisation was considering locating its head office in Wealdstone.
3. An adviser to the Panel welcomed the proposal to change the use of the premises to offices, as the staff employed would then make use of the shops in Wealdstone. She advised the Panel that permission had previously been given for a 4 star hotel to be located on the site but that it had always been used as a hostel. She expressed concern that there might be the potential for further social housing in Wealdstone.
4. The Panel noted that the application was inconsistent in that it referred to the premises as both a hostel and hotel and indicated that this would require clarification. They further noted that the Development Control Committee was required to consider each application on its own merits.
5. The Panel, having expressed a number of concerns, welcomed the application and its proposed change of use, including the proposed length of time the permission would be granted for, and

RESOLVED: That the Panel's views be forwarded to the Development Control Committee.

### 2.1 Brief History

On 5 November 2003, the Development Control Committee considered a planning application for the development of a 3-storey auditorium with foyer linked to music school and drama studio and the relocation of the cello room at the North London Collegiate School, Canons Drive, Edgware.

The Committee resolved to grant planning permission subject to the completion within one year of a Section 106 Agreement. The one-year period for completion of the Section 106 Agreement expired on 5 November 2004.

The delay in completing the 106 Agreement had been due to errors in the plan, which accompanied the original planning application. The negotiations for the 106 Agreement have now been completed and the applicants have executed the engrossments. The documents are now awaiting sealing by the Council. An extension was required until 28 February 2005 to seal and complete the Agreement.

The action below was determined in accordance with the delegation to Chief Officers to act on behalf of the Authority in matters of urgency where it is not practicable to obtain the approval of the appropriate Committee.
