30 minute "drinking up" time will allow appropriate dispersal, use of lavatories etc
In order to further the licensing objectives the licensee reserves the right to move the fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The exterior areas of the pub are illuminated.
All trading area within the bar can be observed by staff from behind the bar counter.
The main entrance is directly in front of the bar counter and the garden is accessed from within the bar, therefore customer movement at these points can be easily monitored by staff.
Licensees are members of Pub Watch
Most customers are mainly local people

All current staff hold Basic Food Hygiene certificates.
Fire fighting equipment is available and inspected annually.

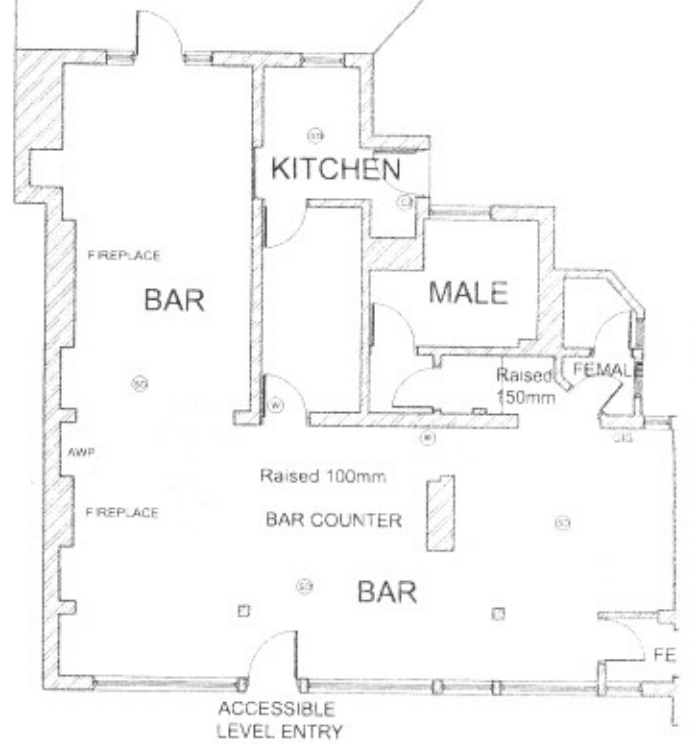
