# **Section 2 - Report**

#### **Current situation**

2.1 The applicant, Mr Mylvayanam Asokan, has applied for a new premises licence in respect of 'Hill Foods', 43 High Street, Harrow on the Hill, HA1 3HT. The application seeks to permit the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises only during the following timings:

Sale of Alcohol:

Mondays to Saturdays 07.00am - 11.00pm Sundays 09.00am - 10.00pm

Hours Open to Public:

Mondays to Saturdays 07.00am - 11.00pm Sundays 09.00am - 10.00pm

- 2.2 The premises is situated at 43 High Street, Harrow on the Hill, HA1 3HT in a parade of commercial premises with residential properties and Harrow School in the immediate vicinity. A map of the area is attached to this report.
- 2.3 The application proposes that Mr Mylvayanam Asokan will be the designated premises supervisor, authorising sale of alcohol at the premises. It should be noted that Mr Mylvayanam Asokan does not currently hold a personal licence and, at this moment in time, no application has been made to Harrow Council as the relevant authority for a personal licence for Mr Mylvayanam Asokan.

## Representations

2.4 The application for a new premises licence has attracted three representations from interested parties; two representations oppose the application and one representation supports the application. Copies of the representations received are attached to this report.

#### Consultation

2.5 The application was advertised in accordance with the Regulations under the Licensing Act 2003.

## **Licensing Policy Implications**

2.6 In relation to the Council's Licensing policy at paragraphs 8.3 and 8.8, the applicant has addressed how he intends to promote the licensing objectives.

## **Legal Implications**

2.7 The Licensing Panel is required to hold a hearing to consider the application and any relevant representations unless all parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary. The

hearing must be held in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005.

- 2.8 The Licensing Panel is required to give appropriate weight to the representations (including supporting information) presented by all the parties, the Guidance issued pursuant to section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, the Council's statement of licensing policy and the steps that are necessary to promote the four licensing objectives.
- 2.9 Having considered those relevant matters, the Licensing Panel is required to take such of the following steps (if any) as it considers necessary for the promotion of the four licensing objectives –

The steps are—

- (a) to grant the licence subject to-
  - (i) conditions that are consistent with the operating schedule accompanying the application modified to such extent as the authority considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives, and
  - (ii) any condition which must under section 19, 20 or 21 Licensing Act 2003 be included in the licence;
- (b) to exclude from the scope of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates;
- (c) to refuse to specify a person in the licence as the premises supervisor;
- (d) to reject the application

For the purposes of 2.9(a)(i) above, the conditions of the licence are modified if any of them is altered or omitted or any new conditions added.

- 2.10 It should be noted with all options that
  - Clear reasons should be given for the decision.
  - Any additional or modified conditions should be practical and enforceable
  - The applicant and any person who made relevant representations would have the right of appeal to a magistrates' court on one of the grounds provided in Schedule 5 to the Licensing Act 2003
- 2.11 In addition to determining the application in accordance with the legislation, Members must have regard to
  - The common law rules of natural justice
  - The provisions of the Human Rights Act 1998
  - The considerations in section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998
- 2.12 By section 6 of the Human Rights Act 1998, the Panel is required to act in a way that is compatible with rights under the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights. The following provisions of the European convention seem relevant: Article 6

(right to a fair trial) Article 14 (prohibition of discrimination) and Article 1 of the First Protocol (protection of property).

## **Community Safety**

2.13 In relation to section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998, this states:

'Without prejudice to any other obligation imposed on it, it shall be the duty of each authority to which this section applies to exercise its various functions with due regard to the likely effect of the exercise of those functions on, and the need to do all that it reasonably can to prevent, crime and disorder in its area.'

The Borough Commander has not made a representation against this application.

## **Financial Implications**

2.14 There are no financial implications.

## **Risk Management Implications**

2.15 If any party is aggrieved with the decision of the licensing panel on one of the grounds set out in Schedule 5 to the Licensing Act 2003, they can appeal to a Magistrates' Court. The Appeal period is 21 days from notification of the decision.







I am writing to give my support to a licence application for 43 High Street, Harrow-on-the-Hill. As a local resident, I am often frustrated by the lack of an ability to buy alcohol on the Hill and frequently make the journey to South Harrow for such purposes. However, this is often an inconvenience and I wholeheartedly welcome the possibility of this changing.

The simple reason is that the shops here already sell an 18 rated product, namely nicotine with no issues. #### Premises License Application - 43 High Street, Harrow on the Hill

I am in receipt of a letter from Mr Ash Waghela, Licensing Support Officer, dated 30 December 2011 (ref; ce/css/lic/HFR1) concerning the above.

With regard to the application for a liquor license for the above premises I wish to make the following points:

- I do not have any objection at all to the principle of the application in terms of liquor being sold from those premises as it will be a further amenity for Harrow on the Hill.
- I do, however, wish to raise an objection to the hours during which liquor will be able to be sold. I note that every day, liquor could be sold until 11pm which I feel is too late for the following reasons;
  - The shop's current operating hours are different from that time and it usually closes much earlier than 11pm
  - o Is the shop owner proposing to have longer operating hours now?
  - o if liquor is sold until 11pm each day I feel there will be a risk of an increased level of public nuisance at that late hour.

In summary, whilst I support the application, I do have concerns about the 11pm time in the proposal and therefore request that this time should be earlier to link in with the opening hours of the shop

I will be very happy to expand on the above points if it is considered necessary.

# LICENSING ACT 2003 - NEW PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION FOR HILL FOODS, 43 HIGH STREET, HARROW ON THE HILL, MIDDLESEX HA1 3HT - OBJECTION

Thank you for your letter dated 30 December 2011 notifying us of an application for the sale of alcohol for the above premises.

Harrow School object to the granting of this licence on the following grounds:

#### The Protection of Children from Harm

This shop, formally known as Oakwoods, is visited on a daily basis by numerous children from local schools including Harrow School. Whilst we acknowledge that the applicant has stated that "All staff will be trained in an Age Verification policy to prevent underage sales of alcohol" in reality this can be extremely difficult to monitor and enforce.

In addition to the close proximity of other Schools and Sixth Form Colleges, these premises are located at the heart of Harrow School with 820 pupils who also live at the School seven days per week throughout term time. It is for this reason that such a high proportion of children visit these premises and a licence to sell alcohol would put them at risk.

#### The Prevention of Public Nuisance, Crime and Disorder

Having regard to the extended hours proposed and the small green immediately opposite, it is felt that the sale of alcohol could easily result in the creation of a public nuisance and the possibility of crime and disorder, particularly during the extended daylight hours of spring and summer months.

This is a predominantly residential area and alcohol abuse could put local residents including pupils at Harrow School at risk in each of those respects.

Previous applications for a licence to sell alcohol from these premises have been refused and it is hoped that this application will also be refused.

# **Section 2 - Report**

#### **Current situation**

- 2.1 An application has been made to vary a premises licence in respect of "Kemps Fish Bar', 327 High Road, Harrow Weald ('the Premises').
- 2.2 The Premises currently has the benefit of a Premises Licence which was granted in 2005 under the Transitional arrangements. Briefly the current premises licence authorises the following licensable activities and timings:

Sale of alcohol (for consumption on the premises only):

Mondays to Sundays 11.00am – 11.00pm

Late Night Refreshment:

Sundays to Thursdays 11.00pm – Midnight

Fridays and Saturdays 11.00pm – 01.00am (next day)

Hours Open to Public:

Sundays to Thursdays 11.00pm – Midnight

Fridays and Saturdays 11.00pm – 01.00am (next day)

- 2.3 Initially the variation application sought to extend the timings for licensable activities until 02.00am the following morning on each night and the addition of recorded music. However following discussions with the Police Licensing Sergeant, the applicant has amended his application.
- 2.4 The application now seeks to extend the timings for licensable activities as follows and to include the provision of Recorded Music as another licensable activity:

Sale of Alcohol (for consumption on or off the premises):

Sundays to Thursdays 11.00am - Midnight

Fridays and Saturdays 11.00am – 01.00am (next day)

Recorded Music: Sunday to Thursday 11.00am - midnight

Friday and Saturday 11.00am - 01.00am (next day)

2.5 The applicant's proposed steps to promote the licensing objectives are listed in Section P of the application.

### Representations

2.6 The application to vary a premises licence has attracted six representations from interested parties. These representations primarily raise issues pertaining to the prevention of public nuisance which the panel should consider when determining the application. The panel cannot consider issues that do not go towards the promotion of the licensing objectives and can only consider matters pertaining to the licensing objectives raised in the representations and any supporting documentation submitted in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005.

2.7 Copies of all the representations received are attached to this report.

#### Consultation

2.8 The application was advertised in accordance with the Regulations under the Licensing Act 2003.

## **Licensing Policy Implications**

2.9 In relation to the Council's Licensing policy at paragraphs 8.3 and 8.8, the applicant has addressed how he intends to promote the licensing objectives.

## **Legal Implications**

- 2.10 The Licensing Panel is required to hold a hearing to consider the variation application and any relevant representations unless all parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary. The hearing must be held in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005.
- 2.11 The Licensing Panel is required to give appropriate weight to the representations (including supporting information) presented by all the parties, the Guidance issued pursuant to section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, the Council's statement of licensing policy and the steps that are necessary to promote the four licensing objectives.
- 2.12 Having considered those relevant matters, the Licensing Panel is required to take such of following steps (if any) as it considers necessary for the promotion of the four licensing objectives
  - a. To modify the conditions of the licence
  - b. To reject the whole or part of the application

and for this purpose the conditions of the licence are modified if any of them is altered or omitted or any new conditions added.

- 2.13 It should be noted with all options that
  - Clear reasons should be given for the decision.
  - Any additional or modified conditions should be practical and enforceable
  - The applicant and any person who made relevant representations would have the right of appeal to a magistrates' court on one of the grounds provided in Schedule 5 to the Licensing Act 2003
- 2.14 In addition to determining the application in accordance with the legislation, Members must have regard to
  - The common law rules of natural justice
  - The provisions of the Human Rights Act 1998
  - The considerations in section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998

2.15 By section 6 of the Human Rights Act 1998, the Panel is required to act in a way that is compatible with rights under the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights. The following provisions of the European convention seem relevant: Article 6 (right to a fair trial) Article 14 (prohibition of discrimination) and Article 1 of the First Protocol (protection of property).

## **Community Safety**

2.16 In relation to section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998, this states:

'Without prejudice to any other obligation imposed on it, it shall be the duty of each authority to which this section applies to exercise its various functions with due regard to the likely effect of the exercise of those functions on, and the need to do all that it reasonably can to prevent, crime and disorder in its area.'

The Borough Commander has not made a representation against this application.

## **Financial Implications**

2.17 There are no financial implications.

## **Risk Management Implications**

2.18 If any party is aggrieved with the decision of the licensing panel on one of the grounds set out in Schedule 5 to the Licensing Act 2003, they can appeal to a Magistrates' Court. The Appeal period is 21 days from notification of the decision.
