Further to my letter dated 8 October 2012 and our subsequent telephone conversation, I received a visit from Dr Patel and Mr Patel to discuss my objections to their application to extend the licenced hours of the Krazzy 4 club in Whitchurch Parade.

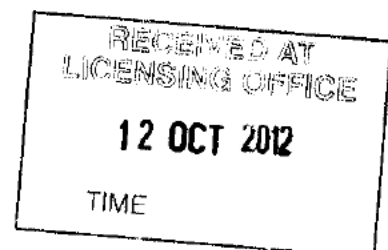
They persuaded me that they are implementing additional noise attenuation measures which will reduce the likelihood of noise emanating from the club. They also explained that they have made strenuous efforts to attract a mature clientele and regard rowdy behaviour as a threat to their business as much as it is to local residents. I can certainly confirm that I have not witnessed a recurrence of any disturbance since the present owners took over the club three years ago. I therefore wish to withdraw my first two objections to their application. However, I am still worried that people leaving the club at 2.00 a.m. will make a noise in our street, so my third objection still stands. In view of these changes I imagine you will require me to complete a new representation form. This is attached.

However, my wife believes that representations should continue to be made on the basis of my original submission, so she has completed a separate representation form. This is also enclosed.

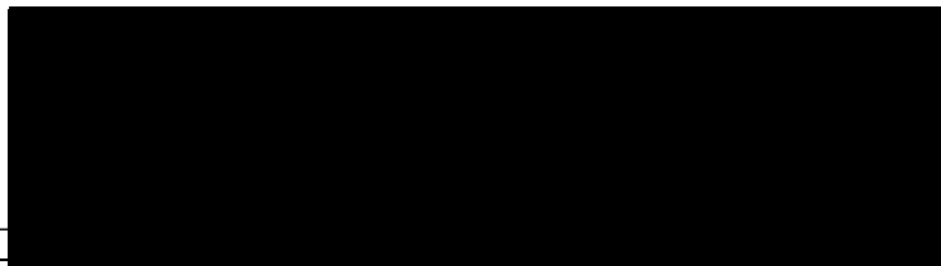
