ROSSLYN CRESCENT	Objecting to the non extension of the control times of the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ). They claim to have never received the previous Public Consultation documents. If they had, they would have made sure more residents responded in favour of the extension of the control times of the CPZ	Not possible to object to something that is not happening. Like a large percentage of the properties in the area this respondent is from a multi occupancy dwelling. This is indicated by more than one door bell on the front door but only has one postal slot in the front door. The consultation documents are hand delivered to each dwelling with enough documents put through the door to match the number of door bells or numbers. The council has no control over what happens to the documents after they are through the door. It may be possible that other residents at the dwelling have taken all documents or not shared the information with all residents in the dwelling.
