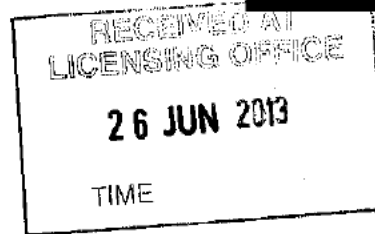
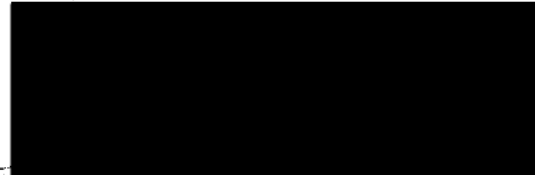

Re Alcohol Licence, Barnet Football Club, The Hive, Camrose Avenue, Edgware, HA8 6AG

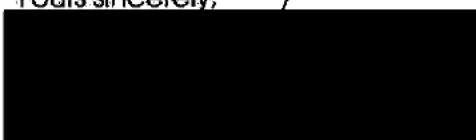
As a local resident of the area surrounding the site, I am writing to lodge my objections to the proposed extension of the alcohol licence at the above premises.

My specific objections are:-

1. The proposed extension to 3am is completely unacceptable in this residential area. The limit should be retained at the existing level to prevent noise, nuisance and anti-social behaviour.
2. The proposed extension of the licence to all four sides of the stadium should not be granted as this would mean that a whole series of parties/functions could be conducted on any one evening leading to further anti-social behaviour, noise and nuisance for local residents.
3. The local area already experiences problems with users of the site parking in the residential area; the proposed extension to the licence would inevitably lead to a more intensive use of the site and create even more car parking problems in the residential area.
4. The proposed 24 hour licence on New Year's Eve/New Year's Day is completely unacceptable and could lead to widespread drunkenness, anti-social behaviour, noise and nuisance for local residents.

I trust that Harrow Council will accept these objections and refuse this application.
