My wife and I have lived in Corkins Lane for 49 years and have found that the Clubs management of it's existing licence has deteriorated significantly over recent years local residents have often had to reduce music played extremely loud, with members singing and shouting outside the premises which makes sleep impossible.

Whilst I have not felt able to confront the occupants in person, fearing trouble or threats to my person, I have tried telephoning. Unfortunately my calls

Although the club states they have been in regular contacts with surrounding residents I have never been in touch with anyone from the club for all the years at my current address.

There often appears to be after hours drinking, smokers who have to go outside to smoke can easily be heard talking etc. from my bedroom and they are also very loud when leaving the club

The club is not managed properly at present and any increase in their licence would be completely unacceptable

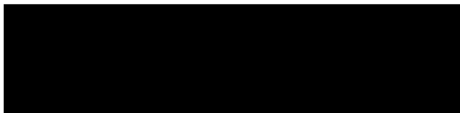
I am writing to object to this application, on the grounds of prevention of public nuisance and prevention of crime and disorder.

The existing occasional live music from the club already constitutes a significant noise nuisance to the nearby houses and flats in Valentine Road, Beechwood Gardens and Corbins Lane. I believe at least 50 households are directly affected by the music, which prevents sleep even with double-glazing. To extend live music until 3am at weekends and recorded music during the week would create completely unacceptable noise nuisance.

The extension of drinking hours would increase the risk of crime and disorder by effectively creating a new night club in a quiet and peaceful neighbourhood. This is an entirely inappropriate location for such activities, and I am sure that the Police would not welcome it.

I urge the Licensing Committee to reject any increase in drinking hours, recorded and live music.

I write in response to the application to change the hours open to public and the sale of retail alcohol, and addition of licensable activities (live music and recorded music) for South Harrow Sports & Social Club, Valentine Road, Harrow, HA2 8EG.

I would like to object to the application on the grounds of prevention of public nuisance.

## Appendix D - Representations

Currently, the club is not often busy, and the activities do not often create a nuisance, however on the odd occasion when they have a late night function, the noise from the club is loud during the evening and especially so around the end of the function. This is due in part to the escaping sound of recorded music as people open the doors to enter and exit, conversations outside the doors where people congregate to smoke, and part due to the noise of them getting into their cars, driving down Valentine road, or walking down Valentine Road and talking noisily.

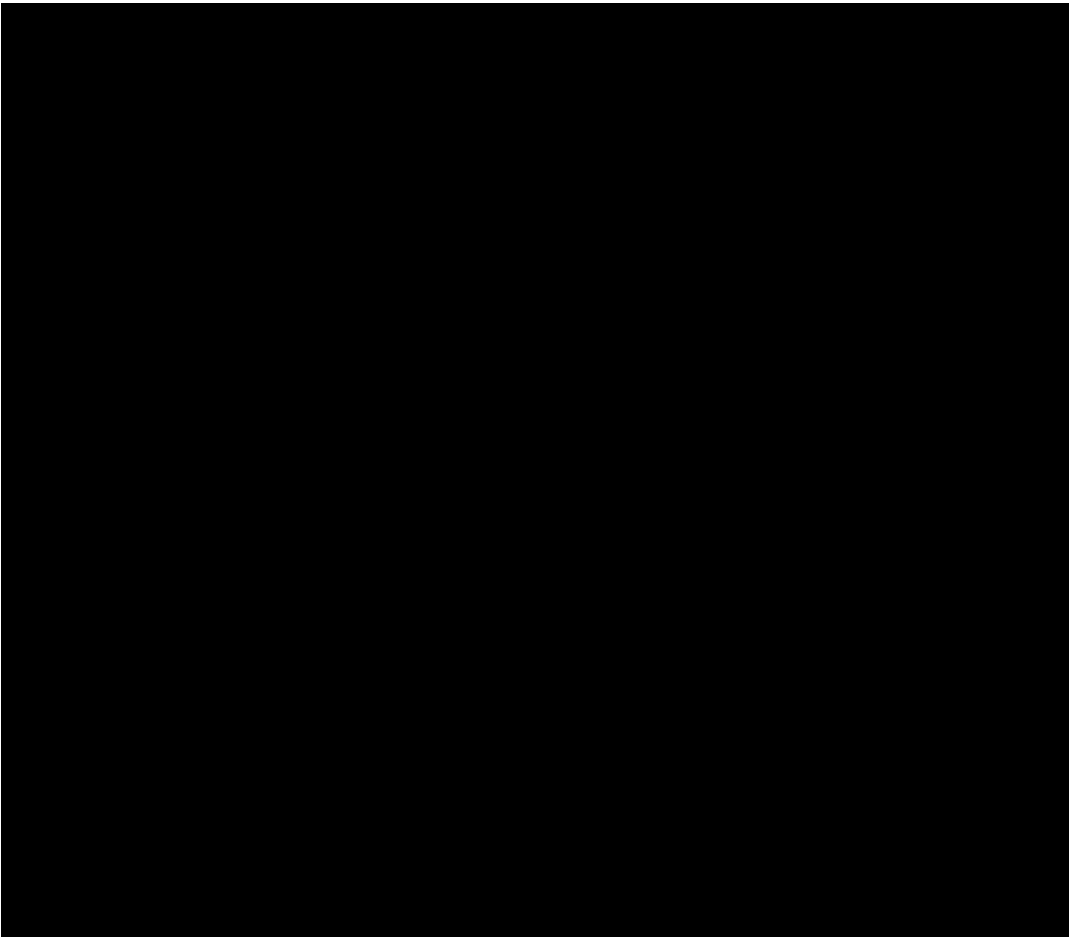
I know that the club cannot be held responsible for the actions of customers once outside the club, but the current noise around midnight is a good marker for what could be expected at around 3am if the weekend extension is granted. The noise nuisance would make sleeping at weekends difficult, and midweek disturbed. Putting up a "Please respect our neighbours" sign is unlikely to help, the application claims that members are already aware of the rules that require them to behave considerately, they are clearly unaware of the effects their behaviour has.

I note that the application also claims that the Club are in regular contact with the residents to ensure there are no problems. This is untrue, the club has not been in contact with me in the seven years I have lived here.

Valentine road is a narrow road, and parking is at a premium. When there is a big function at the club it is already harder to find parking in the road, or other local roads. I imagine the reason for changing the opening hours and activities undertaken is to increase the number of customers. This can only have a detrimental effect on the parking available to residents, and the noise caused by people driving up to the club and reversing back when they find no parking there.

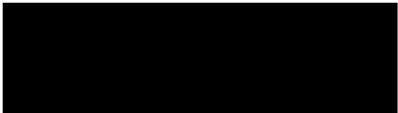
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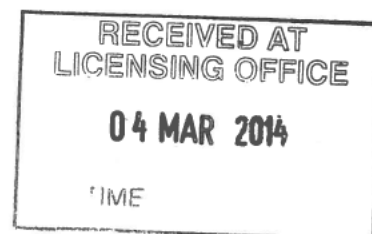

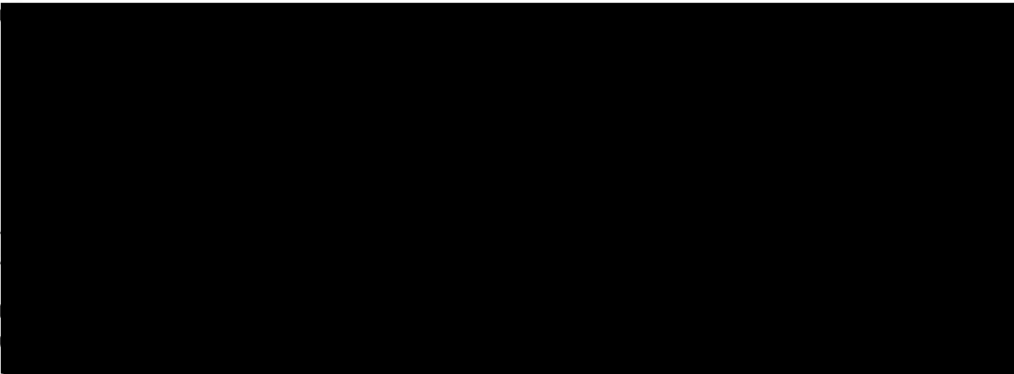

I have lived here for over 30 years and have found that whenever the club holds parties (usually Saturday nights) the music has been excessively loud and therefore I cannot get to sleep, till the party music has stopped. This is worse in the summer when participants leave the doors open, presumably due to the heat, and stroll around in the club garden. Drinkers often raise their voices to an unacceptable level. Items such as cans and condoms get thrown into my garden. On one occasion following a party some of the revellers climbed into my garden and broke into my bike shed. This was about 10 years ago and I reported it to the police. The club owners have never ever contacted me to advise that a party has been arranged, nor enquired about how the noise affects us. The problems are bad enough already. Extending the duration of the nuisance till 3am can only make the situation worse.

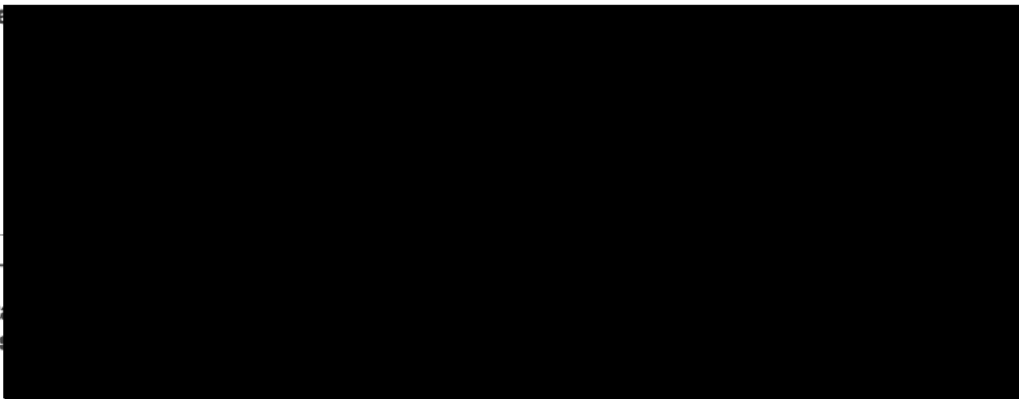

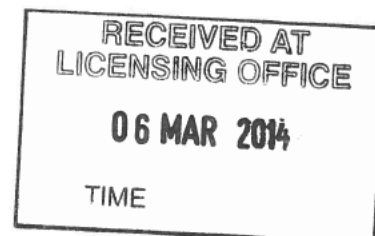

Therefore, any extension to the licence would only lead to further problems. Contrary to the club's application, no consultant or even contact has taken place with residents.

Most Recent examples:

- 22nd February 2014 - noise from the club kept residents awake at least two hours after their official current licence permits.
- Residents complain of loud music and voices coming from the club. Because the building is a pre-fab construction there is no sound-proofing. However, the situation is made worse by doors left open during warmer months / for access to smoking area and outside picnic tables.
- Residents complain that, ~~there is a~~ ~~function~~ as a result of late-drinking at the club, they do not always get adequate sleep to go to work and do their jobs properly. Many families have young children - their sleep has also been disrupted. The only apparent attempt to contain noise when members leave the club - a poster <sup>on the door asking for consideration</sup> - is completely ineffective. In short - the club ~~has~~ <sup>appears to have</sup> no effective way of managing its current licence. This leads to unacceptable noise levels, after hours drinking, anti-social behaviour.

This has led to many examples of public nuisance, particularly noise from live music and shouting and singing outside the club which regularly interrupts and prevents sleep.
