The applicant has failed to provide information within the application as to how public nuisance is to be prevented with regard to noise from patrons in and outside the premises and from equipment within the premises. Although some information regarding the control of litter has been provided this is not deemed satisfactory.

Please provide as much information as possible to support the application (please read guidance note 2)

Further information is required regarding how the applicant intends to prevent noise from patrons disturbing local residents such as keep doors and windows closed. It would be expected that consideration would be made to ensure patrons leave the premises quietly such as the provision of signs on the doors, staff to prevent loitering by customers outside the premises. Information about preventing large queues a peak time has also not been supplied.

It would be expected that to prevent litter in the local area staff undertake regular litter picks, and customers are provided with other information about disposing of litter carefully.

Reference has not been made regarding the control of noise and odour nuisance from extracts and other catering equipment in the premises.


