Following an assessment of the premises and its surrounding area the following is proposed:
30 minute "drinking up" time will allow appropriate dispersal, use of lavatories etc
In order to further the licensing objectives the licensee reserves the right to move the fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

There is good illumination at the front of the pub and the rear outside drinking area.
The bar counter is centrally located allowing staff a good view of the trading area and toilet access points from behind the counter. CCTV is also installed, monitoring car park bays, garden and interior of bar.
The management and staff routinely monitor customer behaviour, especially during busy periods and conduct regular checks on the toilets.
The premises have a burglar alarm system and a panic alarm linked to a central monitoring centre.
A zero tolerance policy is adopted over the possession or use of drugs on the premises.

c) Public safety

A Health & Safety risk assessment is in place and checked on a quarterly basis.
The pub is equipped with emergency lighting, illuminated exit signs and a fire detection system throughout.
All fire fighting equipment is inspected annually and a service contract in place with Fire Safety Services, Bedford.
All portable electrical appliances are tested annually and there are current electric and gas certificates in place.
The pub complies with smoking charter and has mechanical smoke extraction and an smoke filter in the bar.
An accident / incident book is on site for staff and public and the pub has first aid facilities.
All kitchen based food handlers are required hold Basic Food Hygiene certificates.
A pest control contract is in place.
Maximum assistance is given to disabled persons at all times.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

This public house is a detached property, which helps to minimise noise transfer to neighbours. There are no opening windows in the music area of the pub and a noise limiter is also in operation, which is a condition of the Public Entertainment Licence.
The entrance doors have internal lobbies which also helps to reduce noise emission.
When required, staff organise taxis to transport customers home and if necessary, customers are seen off the premises and encouraged to disperse quietly at closing time.
There is good access to Public Transport and late night buses, which helps with the dispersal of patrons.

e) The protection of children from harm

Unaccompanied children are not permitted on the premises and children are not permitted on the premises after 19:00hrs save use of the patio, toilets and function room.
The outside patio area is completely enclosed and accessed through the Lounge bar and car park.
The AWP's and Cigarette machine are within sight of the bar counter and supervised by staff.
