- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above mentioned orders under Sections 6, 7, 45, 46, 47, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the orders would be to make minor extensions to the existing Pinner CPZ A, and introduce a small number of new controlled parking zones in individual roads in Pinner. The opportunity has been taken to review the provision of existing permit bays in Zone A, and provide additional bays where considered appropriate. There are some roads proposed to be included in the existing Zone A, and five new proposed zones comprising five separate areas, all having their own non-transferable zone permit. The zones proposed are as follows;
- (a) Zone A is proposed to be extended into Amberley Close, Cranbourne Drive, Malpas Drive and Nower Hill. Operating times proposed are 11am to 12 noon Monday to Friday, the same as the existing CPZ A operating times. Yellow lines and parking bays would be signed.
- (b) Zone A1 proposes to remove Cecil Park from Zone A. Cecil Park is proposed to be a single road zone with it's own permit. Only addresses in Cecil Park, No. 28 Marsh Road, the Library and Synagogue, would be eligible for a Zone A1 permit. Zone A1 is proposed to operate between 11am to 12 noon and 3pm to 4pm, Monday to Friday. Yellow lines and parking bays would be signed.
- (c) Zone A2 is proposed to comprise Barrowdene Close. It is proposed to be a single road zone with it's own permit. Only addresses in Barrowdene Close would be eligible for a Zone A2 permit. Zone A2 is proposed to operate between 11am to 12 noon, Monday to Saturday. The zone would be signed "permit holders only past this point", and not have parking bays marked, only yellow lines where no waiting at any time is proposed.
- (d) Zone A3 is proposed to comprise Bell Close. It is proposed to be a single road zone with it's own permit. Only residents of Bell Close would be eligible for a Zone A3 permit. Zone A3 is proposed to operate between 8am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. The zone would be signed "permit holders only past this point", and not have parking bays marked, only yellow lines where no waiting at any time is proposed.

- (e) Zone A4 is proposed to comprise Mayfield Drive. It is proposed to be a single road zone with it's own permit. Only residents of Mayfield Drive would be eligible for a Zone A4 permit. Zone A4 is proposed to operate between 8am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. The zone would be signed "permit holders only past this point", and not have parking bays marked, only yellow lines where no waiting at any time is proposed.
- (f) Zone A5 proposes to remove Ashridge Gardens and Holwell Place from Zone A. Ashridge Gardens and Holwell Place are proposed to be their own zone with a shared permit. Only residents of Ashridge Gardens and Holwell Place would be eligible for a Zone A5 permit. Zone A5 is proposed to operate between 8am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. Yellow lines and parking bays would be signed.
- 3. Permits if required would cost the following per household: 1st vehicle £64.90, 2nd vehicle £97.30, 3rd vehicle £129.80, 4th and subsequent vehicles £162.20 each. Visitor permits would cost £16.20 per quantity of ten, 50% discount for OAP's.
- 4. The general effect of the waiting and loading restriction amendment order would be to further amend The Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Traffic Order 2008, by providing the waiting restrictions for the proposed operational zone times, and double yellow lines at junctions, bends or narrow points in the roads within the proposed zones. The opportunity has also been taken to provide at any time waiting restrictions at junctions that fall within the original consultation study area, but outside the existing or proposed zones.

At any time waiting and loading restrictions to alleviate congestion are proposed as follows;

- High Street, Pinner, from outside No. 9 to No. 31 on the north side.
- High Street, at its junction with Grange Gardens by the war memorial.
- Love Lane, both sides between Bridge Street and the party wall of Nos. 6 and 8.
- Bridge Street, between both Zebra crossings and to its junction with Marsh Road.
- Chapel Lane, between Bridge Street and the western wall of No.2 Chapel Lane.
- 5. The general effect of the parking places amendment order would be to further amend The Harrow (Parking Places) Traffic Order 2012, so as to make provision for all the proposed designated on-street parking places, the proposed aforementioned zones and Zone A extensions. Additional Pay and Display parking is proposed as follows;
 - 20 spaces in High Street, Pinner
 - 9 spaces in Love Lane
 - 4 spaces in Station Approach

The High Street, Pinner, will retain 15 Zone A permit bays and three disabled bays.


- 6. The general effect of The Harrow (Free Parking Places)(Disabled Persons)(Alternative Hours)(Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 201* is to relocate and make provision for the existing disabled bays within the High Street and Love Lane. These are proposed to remain operational at any time, but have a maximum stay of three hours.
- 7. The general effect of The Harrow (Loading Places) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 201* is to propose a loading bay in both High Street, Pinner, and in Love Lane. These are proposed outside Nos. 18 to 24 High Street, and outside Nos. 8 to 12 Love Lane. They are proposed to operate during 8am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday, and measure 12 metres in length.

- 8. The Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 201* proposes a free parking place outside Nos. 42 to 60 Cannon Lane. This formalises the parking at this location to keep the service road junctions with Cannon Lane clear from obstructive parking, in conjunction with proposed complimentary waiting restrictions.
- 9. The Harrow (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 201* proposes new school keep clear stopping prohibitions in Cecil Park on the inside and outside of the bend, outside the Henry Jackson Centre to No. 15 Cecil Park, and outside Reddiford School Nursery. The stopping prohibitions are proposed to operate between 8.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
- 10. The restrictions referred to in this notice would not apply in respect of anything done at the direction of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a parking attendant or other person authorised by the Council or in certain circumstances, such as the picking up or setting down of passengers, or the carrying out of statutory powers or duties. The usual exemption relating to vehicles lawfully displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" would apply.
- 11. A copy of the proposed orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the orders are available for inspection between 9am and 5pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published, in the One Stop Shop at the Civic Centre. Further information can be obtained by visiting the traffic order page at www.harrow.gov.uk/trafficorders or by QR code on this notice.

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Pinner Area Parking Review

If there is a significant number of objections to what is proposed which demonstrates a consensus around an alternative suggestion or changes, then, if the objections are upheld it may be necessary to give all the affected properties in any such area the opportunity to comment on these changes. This will result in a delay in the scheme being implemented in these areas until there is a clear indication that the affected properties agree to the alterations.

The results and any formal objections will be presented to the next available TARSAP meeting for consideration before proceeding to implementation on the agreed measures. It is anticipated that the results will be reported to TARSAP in December 2014. If there are any formal objections then TARSAP will determine what action needs to be taken. Once approval to proceed has been obtained from the current Portfolio Holder for Environment, Crime and Community Safety the scheme will be given to our contractors to implement and all residents will be informed of the outcome.

Making a formal statutory objection

Under the legislation which controls the statutory consultation process anyone can make a comment or formal statutory objection to the proposals.

However a statutory objection needs to be made in **writing (email is acceptable)** and must include the word **object** or **objection** (to distinguish it clearly from comments). It must also include your name and full postal address and the **reason** for the basis of the objection on how you are **materially affected** by the proposals so that the issue can be considered by the Portfolio Holder. The law sets out a strict timetable for considering formal objections.
