Public Re-Consultation – Cecil Park Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) Review

Background

You may remember that in August 2013 we carried out a public consultation in Pinner for an extended period of 4 weeks to review the parking conditions and controls. We also delivered leaflets to all the households in Cecil Park as part of the review to see if there were any parking problems and if residents wanted changes to the parking controls.

Whilst we can't at this stage publish the full results, there was a relatively disappointing low response rate from Cecil Park. We subsequently received a petition and correspondence from some residents supporting an extra hour (3 – 4pm) to be added to the current CPZ operating times. The requests also included items relating to safety, obstructive parking and driver behaviour and these are being taken forward separately with Reddiford School. Additional request from residents was for 'school keep clear' restrictions (Monday to Friday 8.30am-4.30pm) to be introduced on the bend outside No. 9 Cecil Park to deter obstructive parking.

What happens now?

Having considered the requests and the consultation results, the information was presented to your ward councillors and the Portfolio Holder (PH) for Community Safety and Environment for a decision. Officers have been asked to re-consult Cecil Park and to give residents a final opportunity to respond to let us know if they support:

1. Monday – Friday 11am – 12noon, 3 – 4pm CPZ restriction on Cecil Park
2. School Keep Clear restrictions introduced on the bend outside No. 9 Cecil Park

It is now imperative that you respond to this consultation with your views so that officers are able to clearly identify where the problems exist and what measures to develop for Cecil Park. **The results of this consultation will supersede the previous CPZ consultations and other submissions carried out in Cecil Park and decisions will be based solely on**

what the majority respondents want.

It is important to note that if Cecil Park opts for the extended CPZ hours the road will have a separate permit scheme to that of the peripheral Zone A' permit which operates in the Pinner CPZ. This means residents with 'Zone A' permits cannot park in Cecil Park and vice-versa.

Please **complete the enclosed questionnaire** and **return it in the self addressed pre-paid envelope** no later than **Friday, 20th December 2013**. We will allow for the Christmas post but late responses will not be included in the decision making.

What Happens Next?

Following this consultation, a report will be presented to the Portfolio Holder who will then determine which measures are progressed to the next stage which is Statutory Consultation.

The Statutory Consultation is a formal process necessary to implement parking measures on public roads and this includes all types of bays, waiting restrictions and changes to CPZ hours. The process also gives another opportunity for members of the public to formally object to any proposed measures.

We will inform all residents and businesses consulted at the end of each stage to notify them of the results once a decision has been made. The results and decision will also be published on the Council website following that decision.
