Introduction

Station Road is a main highway corridor which runs through the heart of Harrow and carries significant amounts of traffic and generates large numbers of pedestrian movements. The Council has been successful in securing funding from Transport for London (TfL) to introduce highway improvements in Station Road – Dominion Parade.

The council is also applying to the Mayor's High Street Fund for additional funding to make other sections of Station Road and its parades more attractive and to support local traders and businesses.

Station Road is a key route between the town centres of Harrow and Wealdstone. Surveys have indicated that the western footway is particularly well used by pedestrians accessing local shops, local destinations and public transport links.

Footway widths vary along this corridor and in some sections pedestrians walk in the service roads because this is a more direct route. In order therefore to improve pedestrian facilities and to create a more pleasant environment, the Council intends to make improvements to the footways to make better use of the road space.

The aims of the scheme are as follows:

- Improve pedestrian facilities
- Create a more pleasant and attractive environment
- Improve footway links between Harrow and Wealdstone Town centres.
- Rationalise existing parking
- Support local traders and businesses to play a more active role in managing Station Road

The TfL scheme is spread over a three year period:

- Phase 1 Dominion Parade infill the service road by April 2015
- Phase 2 Central Parade infill the service road and remove bus by-pass by April 2016
- Phase 3 Introduce raised entry treatments at all junctions from Greenhill Way to The Bridge by April 2017

Details of our proposal for Dominion Parade are shown in the enclosed plan for information.

Raised entry treatment

This is a form of road hump which is effective in reducing vehicle speeds. It also provides a level crossing point for pedestrians.
