PETITION REFERRED TO CABINET – RAYNERS LANE LIBRARY CLOSURE

In accordance with the Council's Petition Scheme, Council received a petition containing over 2,000 signatures as follows

- (i) Petition submitted by residents and students of Nower Hill School containing approximately 2,300 signatures stating "We, the undersigned, deplore the proposed closure of Harrow Libraries, particularly that of Rayners Lane, which serves a densely populated area with very few facilities. This Library does excellent work with students and pre-school children and serves as a hub for its diverse community. The loss of this resource would be destructive to the life of the area."
- (ii) Debate was held on the content of the petition.

RESOLVED: That the petition be referred to Cabinet for consideration.
