On behalf of the Council's Community Safety, Community & Environment Services, I confirm receipt of a copy of your application dated 28th May 2015 that I received on 2nd June 2015 regarding the above mentioned property, in relation to the Licensing objective the Prevention of Public nuisance.

I have made the following representation to the Council's Licensing Section with regard to the Licensing objective – Prevention of Public nuisance:

1. Having reviewed the complaint history of this event over the years, there have been consistent noise complaints on all events. You have failed to submit sufficient information on how you will contain noise that would not cause nuisance apart from "We do not wish to come into conflict with the neighbours so we will do all we could to keep noise to a minimum and The Music to be turned off by 20:30". Given this fact of lack of noise management and previous complaints it is my view the TENs application should be refused.
