Petition Requesting the Council to Introduce a CPZ System in Alfriston Avenue, North Harrow

Reference from Council – 20 October 2005

- 1(i) At the meeting of Council held on 20 October 2005, the following petition was presented requesting that the Council introduce a CPZ system in Alfriston Avenue, North Harrow:

- 1(ii) The petition stood referred to the Traffic and Road Safety Advisory Panel for consideration as follows:-

(Minute Number 348 (3)):

‘Submitted by Councillor Anjana Patel comprising 45 letters from residents of Alfriston Avenue, North Harrow, requesting the Council to introduce a Controlled Parking Zone system in their road to counter its use as a traffic “rat run” between Imperial Drive to the Ridgeway.’

- 1(iii) The petition is in the following terms:-

‘Re: Disabled Parking Space / Controlled Parking Zone in Alfriston Avenue

We fully support the implementation of the Controlled Parking Zone in Alfriston Avenue in compliance with the Road Safety Standard.’

2. The Interim Head of Public Realm Infrastructure advised as follows:

An advance copy of the petition was received by the Transportation Department on 6th October 2005. The transportation west area team responded to the head petitioner on the 25th October 2005 explaining that the council had commenced a review of the existing Rayners Lane CPZ.

The letter explained that the review would also consider the possibility of extending the zone. An area to be considered for a possible extension would be determined by a stakeholder group comprising councillors, officers and

representatives of resident and business groups. The head petitioner was further informed that, because of earlier representations and now this petition, it was likely that Alfriston Avenue would be included in the area considered for extension.

The head petitioner was invited to nominate a representative to attend the stakeholder meeting and he replied on 5th November 2005 confirming that two representatives will attend.

The stakeholder meeting will take place early next year and the target completion date is Spring 2007.
