- 1(iii) The petition is in the following terms:-

'We, the undersigned, being concerned residents and parents who regularly use the Pinner Road and George V Avenue crossing, request the Council as a matter of urgency, to improve the pedestrian facilities and to stop possible fatalities to our children and other pedestrians.

Currently:

- It is not possible to see the traffic light signals in order to cross safely.
- Anticipating forthcoming traffic is clearly not a reliable option.
- The turning from Pinner Road into George V Avenue is a blind spot for Pedestrians making it difficult to know when it is safe to cross.
- The junction is confusing and geared towards traffic rather than pedestrians or pupils attending the local schools (eg Nower Hill High and Pinner Park First and Middle).
- The Government would like us to walk to school but there is no incentive if there is a daily issue of safety.'

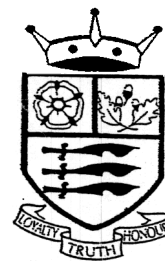
