

# **Consultation On Proposal To Introduce Selective Licensing**

# Wealdstone Ward

Harrow Council has identified areas where there are a number of badly managed and poorly maintained properties which are linked to anti-social behaviour and fly tipping. There is evidence that anti-social behaviour has the largest percentage of the crime types in Wealdstone being 37.06% between June 2014 and May 2015. Please see following link:

This supports previous work in this area that identified large elements of anti-social behaviour and other crimes connected to the private housing sector.

To overcome these problems Harrow Council is considering introducing a Selective Licensing scheme in the **Wealdstone ward.** A Map is enclosed showing the roads affected.

While working in partnership with the police, landlords' agents, tenants etc. our aims are to improve the area to benefit all those that live, work, invest and visit the area, by aiming to have a regulated standard of management and condition of rented properties. This will assist in achieving a settled and diverse community, and attractive area to live, work and visit.

If the Selective Licensing scheme is introduced there will be conditions on the licence that stipulates that the licence holder has valid tenancy agreements, gives rent receipts, safety certificates and obtains references from tenants. Once licenced properties are inspected and are informed if any works needing doing to bring the house up to decent homes standards.

The proposed fee for a licence for up to 5 years would be £550.00. Current members of a Landlord Accreditation Scheme will receive a £75 discount for the first application.

The results of the of the consultation will enable the Council to ensure if through the introduction of the Selective Licensing Scheme, the Council would be able to eliminate your concerns. We will not give your information to anyone else. The information we receive helps us to see if the people who fill in our questionnaire reflect the different groups of people who live in the borough. Under the Data Protection Act 1998, we require your consent to process it. When you fill in the questionnaire you are giving your consent.


