### Summary of applicant's proposed times and conditions for new premises licence: 6 – 7 North Parade, Mollison Way

#### Licensable activities and hours proposed:

#### Summary of applicable mandatory conditions:

- (1) No sales of alcohol without a designated premises supervisor
- (2) Age-verification policy required
- (3) Prohibition against irresponsible alcohol promotions
- (4) Prohibition against selling alcohol below cost price

#### Conditions consistent with the operating schedule and agreed between the applicant and responsible authorities:

- (1) (i) The CCTV system is to be maintained and operated in good order and to the satisfaction of Metropolitan Police's reasonable requests. The medium upon which the images are recorded will be clearly identifiable, stored securely, retained for a period of not less than 31 days and it will be made available to police and licensing authority officers upon written request  
(ii) Such footage must be provided in an immediately viewable format and must include any software etc. which is required to view the footage. Any discs, portable drives or other storage media onto which the footage is transferred must be provided by the premises.
- (2) A centrally monitored alarm system will be in operation at the premises. The system will incorporate a panic button which will be situated near the counter area.
- (3) A minimum of two staff will be employed after 2000 hours until the terminal hour each day.
- (4) Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at the entrance/exit requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- (5) The age verification policy shall apply to persons who appear to be under the age of 21 years old ("Challenge 21 policy"). A record of age related refusals of sale will be kept and will be made available to officers of the police or licensing authority immediately upon request.
