Over the last year initiatives from the DWP have continued, specifically the Real Time Information Bulk Data Matching exercise (RTI), which means the DWP is now providing retrospective information to the authority about claimant changes not previously known to Harrow. This has resulted in a higher than normal increase in the raising of Housing Benefit overpayment debts which in turn has lead to higher bad debt provision being required.
