## Amendment to Motion 1 – Condemn Racism, Xenophobia and Hate Crimes Motion

"We are proud to live in a diverse and tolerant society. Racism, <u>xenophobia and hatexenophobia</u>, <u>hate</u> crimes <u>or crimes of any sort</u> have no place in <u>our any countrysociety</u>. We, the London Borough of Harrow, condemn <u>racism</u>, <u>xenophobia and hate-all</u> crimes unequivocally <u>and especially those</u> <u>crimes that are particularly heinous</u>, <u>such as racially aggravated crimes and offences against the</u> <u>person</u>.
