Asked of: Councillor Sachin Shah, Chair of the Health and Wellbeing Board

Question: I am a kidney transplant recipient and a Harrow resident and wish to ask the following question. About 1 in 3 people with diabetes will develop kidney disease during their lifetime although a small proportion will end up needing dialysis or a kidney transplant. Black Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) groups are 3 times more likely to have kidney failure than white people but many are not aware of this. Does the draft Harrow Diabetes Strategy take sufficient account of the close link between kidney disease and diabetes for the multi ethnic population of Harrow?
