The Committee is also asked to provide feedback to inform the development of the Community Safety Strategy. Particular issues for attention from the local data for the year-ended December 2017 are as follows:

- 1. Increase in crime in Harrow, but the Borough's overall position of lowest crime rates in London is maintained
- 2. Increases in burglary and artifice (trick or distraction) burglary
- 3. Mixed results from public attitude survey
- 4. Fear of crime levels do not necessarily correspond with local crime rates
- 5. Increases in violent crime and under 25 knife crime
- 6. Increased public concern around gangs despite reduction in recorded 'gang-flagged' offences
- 7. Increase in domestic abuse with injury, repeat victims and the proportion of the victims who are women
- 8. Increases in faith and anti-Semitic hate crime
