# **Section 1 – Summary and Recommendations**

This report welcomes representation from the voluntary sector to Cabinet and explains how the role will work.

### **Recommendations:**

Cabinet is requested to welcome John Higgins as the voluntary sector nonexecutive representative and note how the role will work.

### Reason:

To enable the views of Harrow's voluntary sector to be an integral part of Harrow's executive decision making.

# **Section 2 - Report**

- 2.1 The Council's Constitution allows the Leader to appoint representatives from the voluntary sector to Cabinet, who may speak but not vote on items in meetings.
- 2.2 In accordance with the above provision and following discussions with the Harrow Voluntary and Community Sector Forum, expressions of interest were sought for a representative to sit with Cabinet.
- 2.3 The Forum sought expressions of interest and at its AGM recommended John Higgins to the Council as its representative.
- 2.4 The Leader subsequently accepted the Forum's recommendation and appointed John Higgins as a non-executive representative to sit with Cabinet.
- 2.5 The appointment of a non-executive representative is on the basis that they will:
  - (a) Abide by the Code of Conduct for Members, in particular the 10 General Principles of Conduct;
  - (b) Have no voting rights;
  - (c) Not attend any private meetings of the Cabinet;
  - (d) Receive only public Cabinet Agendas and will not be entitled to receive any Part II/Confidential agenda papers;
  - (e) Not "call in" or be part of any "call in" of a Cabinet decision; and
  - (f) Not ask any public questions at Cabinet Meetings as they can do so as a representative.

#### **Performance Issues**

It is anticipated that the appointment to this role will enhance the decision-making process and assist Cabinet with understanding the issues and opportunities within the Voluntary Sector.

### **Environmental Implications**

There are no environmental impacts associated with this report.

# **Legal Implications**

The Voluntary Sector Representative will sit with and take part in Cabinet discussions. They will not be a member of the Executive, or be entitled to see Part II papers, attend private meetings of Cabinet or vote.

### **Financial Implications**

The Harrow Voluntary Sector Forum will be paid £445 per year to cover expenses that the role may incur from existing budgets within the Strategic Commissioning Division. There is no impact on the members' allowances budget.
