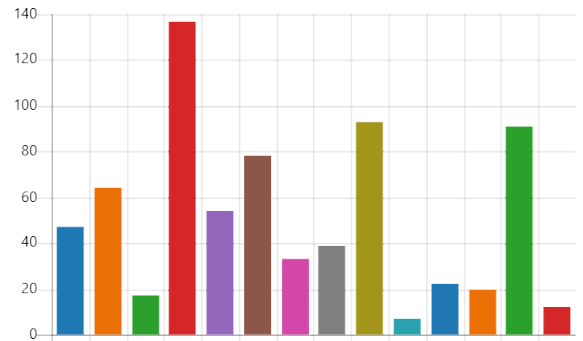

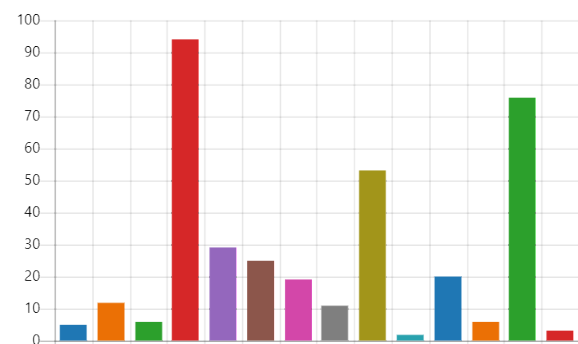

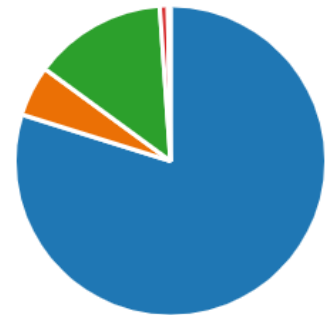

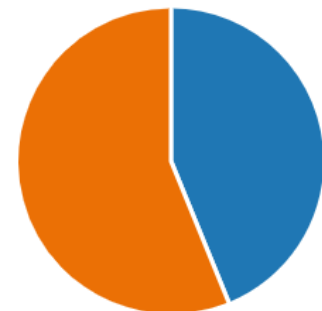

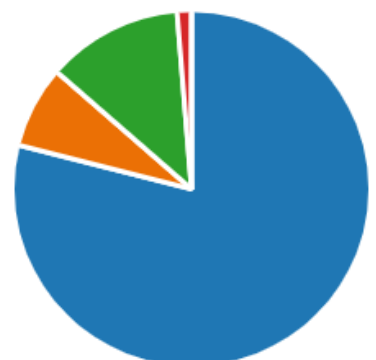

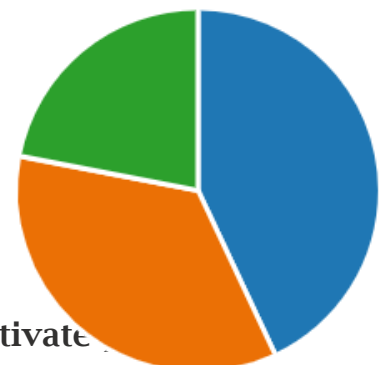

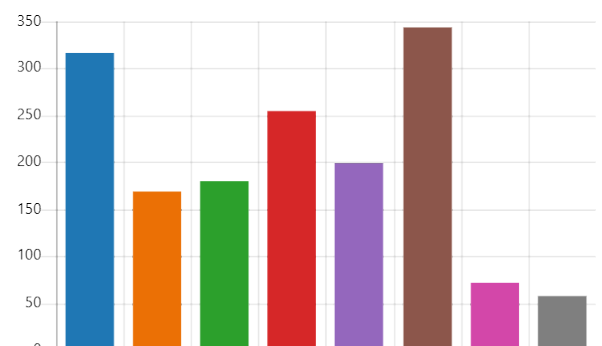
20. If you already play tennis in our parks, would you use a different court if it were in better condition e.g. nearer to your home?

 - Against - 22 (28%)

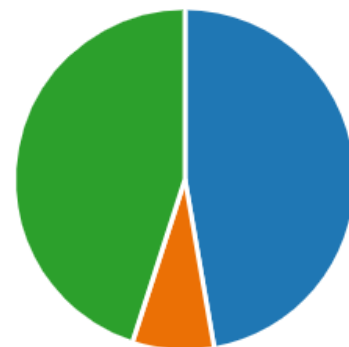

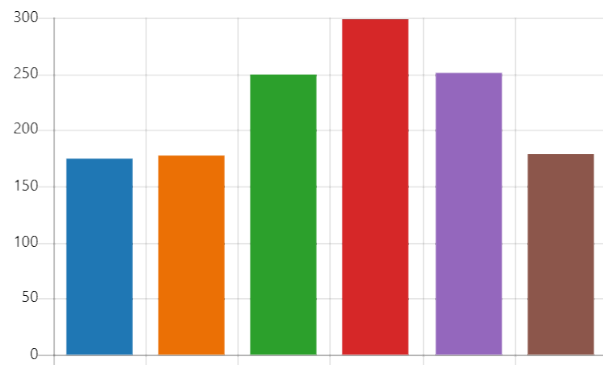

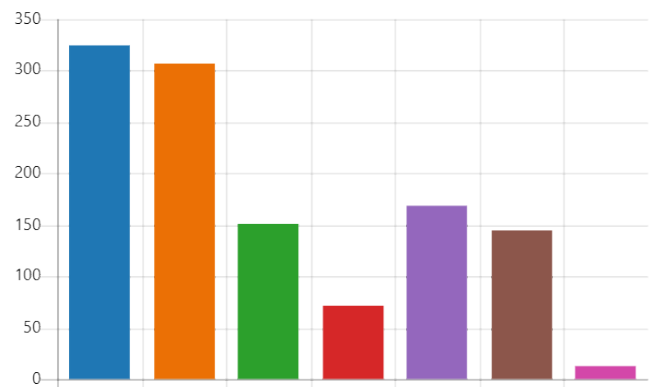
30. What days of the week and time of the day do you think the free coach led sessions should be held?
