MEETING WITH APPLICANT 08/09/2023 – AMENDMENTS REQUESTED

In addition to your proposed conditions Police require the following points should be included in the operating schedule or added as conditions on the premises licence.

1: No super-strength beer, lagers or ciders of 6.5% ABV (alcohol by volume) or above shall be sold at the premises. A log (which may be electronically recorded) shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The log should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer of the licensing authority at all times whilst the premises is open.

AGREED

2: A sign stating 'No proof of age – No sale' shall be displayed at the point of sale. **AGREED**

3: A clear and unobstructed view into the premises shall be maintained. **AGREED**

4: No single cans or bottles of beer/lagers or cider shall be sold at the premises. **AGREED**

AMENDED TO

4: No single cans or bottles of beer/lagers or cider of 500ml or less shall be sold at the premises **AGREED**

5 Notices asking customers to leave quietly shall be conspicuously displayed at the exit.

AGREED

6. All goods, including those subject to duty payments i.e. alcohol and tobacco products will be brought from cash and carries only an invoices and they will be available upon request. All alcohol will be purchased from AWRS registered cash & carry or wholesalers.

AGREED

7. Invoices to be produced to Police or a member of the local authority upon request to evidence payment of duty on goods. **AGREED**

8. No alcoholic drinks or tobacco will be purchased by the premises from unannounced sellers calling at the premises.

AGREED

9. All staff employed at the premises will have UK right to work status checked, once passed that stage they may be offered employment. **AGREED**

10. The venue will maintain a minimum of two staff members from 20.00 hours On Friday and Saturdays.

11. Mrs Mathivathani Kenkarajah must not have any involvement whatsoever in the running of the business at any time whilst the premises are open to the public or carrying out any licensable activity.

Mr Nadarajah Kenkarajah must not have any involvement whatsoever in the running of the business at any time whilst the premises are open to the public or carrying out any licensable activity.
