With reference to the above planning application which was passed in 2004 for a 5-bedroom house, we, the residents, are now objecting to what has turned out to be a development of 7 self contained studio flats each with bathroom and kitchen. This development bears no resemblance to the original plans for the inside and the Planning Enforcement Officer is proceeding with an enforcement notice, which is being put before a meeting in February.

We strongly object to this over development in a quiet residential road:-

1. There is insufficient parking for a possible 7 cars.
2. There is the question of rubbish disposal and recycling. There is the possibility of having 7 green bins, 7 brown bins and 7 recycling bins. Where are they all going?
3. Should this development be allowed to progress (there are now 3 people living there) it will allow other builders to buy up houses here and do the same.
4. We do not want to be living next door to, what is now the case, blocks of flats.

We enclose a petition signed by the people of Norwood Drive and would be pleased if you could look into this case as a matter of urgency.
