## Action Plan 2007-2010

The attached Action Plan lists key areas of Council service provision and identifies a programme for each to undertake an Equalities Impact Assessment. The programme has been formulated to recognise the priority of looking at services which could have a significant effect on equality as early as possible but also to avoid re-assessing too soon services which have been examined recently. The programme has also tried to take into account the cycle of service reviews that the Council adopted in December 2006 as Equalities Impact Assessments can best be undertaken as part of those reviews. The scope of some of these reviews has still to be finalised and so the programme is subject to alteration.

Similarly, the programme has also had regard to the schedule of inspections and external challenges which apply to Council services. Finally, the programme has taken on board the implications of the current re-organisation of the Council and tried to avoid setting the same assessment year for too many services from any one of the new Directorates.
