Complaints listed in e mails sent on 3 Sept 08

1. Only 10 people voted at the meeting to set up Central TMO

The decision to form the Central TMO and ultimately serve the "Right to Manage" notice on the Council was taken on the basis of 20% resident membership (566 in total) and 54 votes including proxy votes at the meeting.

2. That the RTM notice was signed by the Chair and that the chair was not constitutionally elected.

As you are aware, we were working towards the 31st August deadline to complete under the old regulations and avoid the requirement for the Council to contribute financially towards the next stage. Therefore, there was not sufficient time to hold a formal Committee meeting to elect a Chair within that timescale. However, following informal discussions led by Liz it was agreed that Sylvie would act as Chair in order to carry forwards the will of the meeting - ie serving the Right to Manage notice.

The accompanying information that went with the notice to residents (also in the report) made clear that the real work to develop the Committee would take place after funding was received for the next stage.
