

London Borough of Harrow Council Polling District and Places Review 2008

Recommendations of review working group

The Electoral Administration Act 2006 placed a duty on the Council to review its polling districts and places within the Borough every four years from December 2007. This council agreed that reviews would be undertaken every year in respect of selected parts of the Borough.

This Working Group was required to review selected polling districts and recommend the adoption of new polling districts and suitable alternative buildings as polling stations.

The following are the recommended arrangements for each ward by polling district.

Constituency: HARROW EAST

POLLING DISTRICT	POLLING STATION	RECOMMENDATIONS
EBB	Synagogue Community Centre, London Road, Stanmore	No change. Designate polling district as polling place.
EBD	Find new premises to accommodate a polling station for the new polling district.	New polling district created by splitting polling district EBB for 2010 elections. Consider feasibility of Islamic Centre on Wood Lane, Stanmore as an option available for polling station. Designate polling district as polling place.

Constituency: HARROW EAST

Ward: HARROW WEALD

POLLING DISTRICT	POLLING STATION	RECOMMENDATIONS
EGB	Cedars First and Middle School, Whittlesea Road, Harrow Road	No change in 2009. Designate polling district as polling place. Consider splitting the polling district EGB in time for the 2010 elections.

Constituency: HARROW WEST

Ward: HARROW ON THE HILL

POLLING DISTRICT	POLLING STATION	RECOMMENDATIONS
WM	Old Gaytonians Clubhouse, South Vale, Sudbury Hill, Harrow	No change. Designate polling district as polling place. Consider options available for 2010 elections, including, St George's Catholic School, Sudbury Hill.
WMC	Whitmore High School, Porlock Avenue, Harrow	Explore the use of McDonalds car park, Shaftesbury Circle, Harrow to replace Whitmore High School, Porlock Avenue, Harrow as the polling station for polling district WMC for 2009 elections. Designate polling district as polling station. Investigate alternative sites for 2010 elections immediately.

Ward: RAYNERS LANE

U	Tithe Farm Social Club, Rayners Lane	No change. Designate polling district as polling place.

Constituency: HARROW EAST

Ward: WEALDSTONE

POLLING DISTRICT	POLLING STATION	RECOMMENDATIONS
EJC	Whitefriars First & Middle School, Whitefriars Avenue, Harrow	No change. Designate polling district as polling place. Subject to consultation, Salvatorian College to be used as a site for 2010 elections. If Salvatorian is to be used, redefine the ward boundary to use the college as a polling station.

Ward: ROXETH

WSB	Junction of The Heights and Gaylor Road, Northolt	Consult with Ward Councillors to consider the options available for polling site.
