### Grant 2003 2004 and 2004 2005

I refer to our letter of February 11<sup>th</sup> resubmitting the additional information in support of our application and the subsequent deliberations of the grants panel on the 19<sup>th</sup> of February  
You have not advised us formally but we understand that our application was rejected on the basis of 'poor presentation' as the panel could not read the information in front of them

It is the unanimous view of the council nominated members on HiE that we resubmit this grant application and  
On this basis I am re submitting the information in a clearer format and would invite you to present the papers to the officers for inclusion in the next meeting of the Committee on March. 8th

Perhaps on this occasion you could help us by ensuring that the copying process for the papers to the committee enhances the legibility of the application. .

We understand that the additional information attached now meets the requirements of the SLA in full.

This comprehensive programme combines the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Harrow in Europe with the 50th jubilee celebrations of Harrow as a borough in May and October, In addition further community events are planned to take place throughout the year for which we have committed significant funding.

I am pleased to enclose the following documents:

1. A breakdown of our activities giving details of ethnicity, gender, disability and where possible low income as required under the SLA.

2. Outline programme for Harrow in Europe's Silver Celebrations

*' International Year of Friendship 2004'-: cultural understanding through twinning and education*

3 Ongoing: Harrow in Europe's programme of educational field trips and school exchanges, support for disadvantaged groups (e.g. adults with learning difficulties), and promotion of shared cultural activities.

Reverting to the detail of the Silver Celebration, as we discussed Cllr Lammiman sits on the Mayor's panel for the 50<sup>th</sup> celebrations and the programme outlined above goes hand in hand with the civic activities planned for this year .I am pleased to say it also has the support of the Mayor and the Deputy Mayor

On the basis of this information I would be pleased, if on behalf of Harrow in Europe, you could resubmit the papers to the grants committee with a view to their re- instating the reserve of £2500 for 03 /04 and allowing full grant of £5000 for the year 04/05.

Much of our funding is already committed as indicated and the full programme outlined comes to more than £17,000 therefore the monies requested will enable us to fulfil our planned programme and thus the terms of the SLA.

With our current balance and the funding we are requesting we will still have a short fall which we will hope to make up through outside fundraising

This forms the platform for a rolling programme over the next three years to achieve the aims of HiE extending participation and cultural understanding through twinning and education
