### 1. **Summary / Reason for Urgency (if applicable)**

- 1.1 This report provides a detailed tree survey carried out on all the land between Brookshill and Clamp Hill, North of the public footpath linking Brookshill and Clamp Hill, Harrow Weald. A new detailed Tree Preservation Order (TPO) is proposed.

- 2.1 That the Borough Solicitor be authorised to make a new TPO to be known as TPO 724, Clamp Hill (No. 7), Harrow Weald, made pursuant to sections 198 and 201 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to protect those trees identified on the attached map and schedule.

On confirmation of the above: TPO 10, Area 28, to be revoked.
