## 2008/ 2009 HARROW PLACE SURVEY TOPLINE RESULTS

## **Technical note**

## Feb-09

A total of 3600 questionnaires were mailed out to randomly selected addresses between September and December 2008.

1277 valid responses were received representing an adjusted response rate of 36%.

In line with survey guidelines, two full reminder questionnaires were sent to residents who had not responded.

Data are weighted to household composition, age, gender and ethnicity by Cobalt-Sky on behalf of the Department of Communities and Local Government.

Responses to Place Survey statutory questions which cover the 18 citizen perspective National Indicators are based according to guidance set out in the revised Place Survey Manual dated January 2009. In most - but not all - case bases are based on all valid responses.

Responses to non-statutory 'additional' questions are based on all respondents (including don't know and not stateds, etc.) unless drawn from the BVPI question bank, in which case don't know and not stated responses are excluded from the bases.

An \* indicates a score less than 0.5%, but greater than zero.

Where available, results are shown for the 2003/04 and 2006/07 BVPI surveys. Average results are also show for the Inner, Outer and all 33 London Boroughs.
