## Appendix 3 to cabinet report

### Consultation process

Consultation on the CYPP took place From January 5<sup>th</sup> until March 18<sup>th</sup> 2009. The plan is multi-agency and consultation is therefore applied generically to all agencies. A consultation questionnaire was advertised through the Children and Young People's Strategic Partnership and posted on the website and we received 110 responses from staff both in the Council and in partner agencies. In addition to this the table below shows a very brief summary of the key stakeholder groups and how they were consulted;

<b>Key stakeholder</b>	<b>Consultation process</b>
<b>Children and young people</b>	CYP are engaged actively in priority setting and in writing the plan including design and structure. This is carried out with the leadership of the Children and young people strategic partnership "Make a Positive Contribution" sub-group who meet 6 time per year and link with the Youth Council and sub-groups and with schools.
<b>Parents</b>	Parents have been consulted through the provision of a questionnaire on our website and a series of consultation meetings arranged by the Children's Centres.
<b>Schools and Colleges</b>	Consultation has been arranged with the leadership of the Schools and Colleges representation on the Children and Young People's Strategic Partnership.
<b>Voluntary Sector</b>	The plan has been promoted through the HAVS newsletter.
<b>Police</b>	Consultation has been led through the Borough Commander.
<b>Local Safeguarding Children Board</b>	The LSCB has been consulted through an away day in December and (will have) has formally ratified the final draft in April.
A consultation event took place on March 17 <sup>th</sup> with a group of key stakeholders, including parents and children and young people. Comments have been included in the plan.
