## Petition: Speeding, congestion and pedestrian safety on Eastcote Lane

We the undersigned call on Harrow Council and Gareth Thomas MP to urgently undertake an investigation to establish a solution to the excessive speeding, congestion and pedestrian safety along Eastcote Lane, South Harrow.

Many motorists are using this stretch of road like a race track, especially in the evening, with many accidents caused by speeding cars. Indeed, it is now very difficult in accessing Eastcote Lane from the residential side roads or driveways in fear of being struck by a speeding vehicle.

Furthermore, it is nigh on impossible for pedestrians to cross this stretch of road between the crossing near Kings Road and the traffic island by the "Eastcote Arms" roundabout. This is of particular concern with regards to the number of pupils who walk to the local schools and who are currently trying to dodge moving traffic.

Within their investigation to establish a solution to these issues we call on Harrow Council and Gareth Thomas MP to seriously consider: installing parking bays, reduced costs for crossovers, install a new traffic island and install a speed camera.

We also call on Harrow Council and Gareth Thomas MP to resurface the road on the "odd" numbered side, which is full of ruts that are causing cars to swerve and causing a tripping hazard to pedestrians crossing the road.

Finally, we also call on Harrow Council and Gareth Thomas MP to repair/replace the pavements on the "even" numbered side. There have been many trips and falls caused by the damaged pavements and there is no lowered pavement by the alley way leading to primrose close, which is forcing many wheelchair users to go out into the road.
