Section 1 – Summary and Recommendations

This report sets out the background to a new guidance and protocol regarding members' access to information.

Recommendations:

The Committee/Sub-Committee/Panel is requested to:

- 2. Approve the draft for recommendation to Council for inclusion in the Constitution.

Section 2 – Report

Background and current situation

There are a number of legal provisions surrounding the rights of members to access council information.

Currently, there is a brief guidance note for members regarding their rights to confidential information and a guidance note for officers on the procedure for dealing with requests.

Why a change is needed

The Council needs to be mindful of its duties under data protection and other legislation, whilst not unnecessarily restricting the rights of members to access information which they have the right to see and may be necessary for them to carry out their duties, including acting for constituents. This guidance deals in more detail with these issues.

The protocol provides a process for when an officer has doubts as to whether information should be released to a member. If necessary, the Chair of the Standards Committee will be required to make a decision as to whether particular information should be released to a member.

Legal Comments

The adoption of this policy should reduce risks of the Council not complying with the Data Protection Act and other legislation related to information.
