Grounds For Objection

- Impact on residential parking problems outside school hours (i.e. after 6p.m. and weekends).
 Parking outside school hours, is already a major problem, and will be exacerbated by these measures. Residential amenity will be severely reduced. (See Appendix A).
- 2) Residents are and have not been aware of cars exceeding the speed limit on Stafford Road, and there is not a lot of traffic in general. We have no objection to a reduction in the speed limit to 20 mph. However, there is no evidence that it will be necessary to construct speed humps on Stafford Road in order to enforce a speed limit.
- 3) Parking restrictions should be restricted to school times restrictions outside school times are detrimental to residential amenity with no benefit to schools. This would be an unreasonable exercise of power by the Council.
- 4) Safety and Noise. Speed humps slow down emergency vehicles such as ambulances and fire engines. In addition, we are concerned by the noise caused by speed humps. This is a quiet road, which is a major selling point.
- Speed humps will also have a detrimental effect on property prices and rental income, as speed humps are so unpopular with prospective buyers and tenants.
