OPENING OF THE ANNUAL MEETING

By approximately 7.25 pm Members' guests will have occupied the seats reserved for them in the Council Chamber or Public Gallery. By no later than 7.28 pm the Councillors of the London Borough of Harrow will have assumed their places in the Council Chamber seats assigned to them.

The Mayoress will have taken her place near the dais in the Council Chamber.

(all stand)

THE MAYOR the Deputy Mayor and the Mayor's Chaplain will then proceed to their

chairs on the dais and remain standing

THE CHAPLAIN will open the meeting with prayers.

The Chaplain will then either withdraw or occupy a seat alongside the dais.

THE MAYOR will then invite Members to be seated.

(all sit)

ELECTION OF MAYOR

THE MAYOR will call for nominations for the Office of Mayor for the Municipal Year

2010/11.

Councillor Asad Omar will be nominated by Councillor Navin Shah seconded

by Councillor Susan Hall.

THE MAYOR will ask if there are any further nominations

Proposer and Seconder may make speeches in putting forward nominations, and <u>any other Members</u> may speak in support thereof. <u>Also any other Members</u> who have previously indicated a wish too may speak (Councillors Nizam Ismail,

John Nickolay & Nana Asante).

THE MAYOR will put the nominations, in the order in which they are made, to the meeting.

(the vote on each separate nomination will be by the show of hands)

(Note: In the case of an equality of votes, the Mayor is required by law to give a

casting vote)

THE MAYOR will declare the successful candidate to be duly elected Mayor of the London

Borough of Harrow for the ensuing Municipal year.

The newly elected Mayor will mount the dais to accept the congratulations of

the retiring Mayor.

THE RETIRING MAYOR will ask the Council to stand and will then vacate the Chair

(All stand)

The retiring Mayor, the newly elected Mayor, the retiring Deputy Mayor (IF NOT ELECTED), the Proposer and Seconder of the Mayor's nomination, will leave the Council Chamber

(All sit)

After a short interval, **the Mayor's procession** will return to the Council Chamber in the following order:

The newly-elected Mayor

(Robed and wearing Mayoral Chain and Medallion of Office)

The retiring Mayor

The retiring Deputy Mayor

The Proposer and Seconder (Cllrs Navin Shah & Susan Hall)

THE MACE-BEARER will announce

"Members of the Council of the London Borough of Harrow, pray silence for the Mayor"

(All stand)

Members of the Council and others present will stand in their places and remain standing

THE MAYOR will mount the dais and remain standing by the Mayoral Chair, and the Retiring Mayor will also mount the dais and remain standing by the Deputy Mayor's Chair.

> The Proposer and Seconder will pause at the entrance to the Chamber and then return to their places

THE MAYOR will then sign the Declaration of Acceptance of office.

THE MAYOR will invite Members to be seated. He will then speak to advise that in memory of his wife and in recognition of her support that he intends to name her posthumously as his Mayoress as a tribute to her memory. It would be his intention to not appoint an alternative Mayoress/Consort but, instead to invite colleagues from the Council to attend events with him.
