Petition – Requesting Minor Alterations to Double Yellow Lines

Reference from the meeting of Cabinet held on 18 March 2010

- Cabinet, at its meeting on 18 March 2010, received a petition from a local resident signed by 415 people, requested minor extensions to double yellow lines to make exiting onto Headstone Lane from side roads and entry from Headstone Lane into side roads safer.
- 2. The terms of the petition read:

"We the undersigned believe that

- (i) exiting our road onto Headstone Lane presents a serious safety hazard and request the extension of the double yellow lines
- (ii) the traffic lights at the junction of George V Avenue, Headstone Lane and Pinner Road require safety alterations for cars and pedestrians and rephasing to improve traffic flow."

The petition stood referred to the Traffic and Road Safety Advisory Panel.
