Removal Of Parking Controls In Oxleay Road

What is this about?

The Rayners Lane Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) L was originally introduced in 1998 and reviewed/ extended in 2002. It was introduced to prevent all day commuter parking for Rayners Lane Station in surrounding roads, this was based on a majority decision from consulting residents for parking controls.

We are currently conducting a review in other roads to extend the existing zone. This is based on requests from residents as the roads surrounding the zone can suffer from displaced parking. Ward Councillors have informed us they have received requests from some residents of Oxleay Road to consult on removing parking controls in their road.

It should be noted that we are consulting residents in Clitheroe Avenue and Lucas Avenue on whether they wish to be included into the existing Rayners Lane CPZ L (as outlined on the enclosed plan). If residents in these roads demonstrate a majority decision to be included into the existing CPZ and Oxleav Road residents decide to have parking controls removed, then Oxleay Road would most likely suffer from parking displacement. Oxleay Road would be the closest uncontrolled road to Rayners Lane Station and the shopping facilities attracting commuter and shopper parking. Without parking controls any vehicle can park at anytime for any duration. If residents in Clitheroe Avenue and Lucas Avenue choose not to be included this would still make Oxleay Road liable to commuter parking if no parking controls to protect residents were in place.

This is an informal consultation to find out the views of residents and what they would like for Oxleay Road, the council will act on a majority decision from resident responses. If residents show a majority decision for the removal of controls then we would be looking to progress to the next stage which would be a statutory consultation. During the statutory consultation notices will be placed on lamp columns, notices advertised in the Harrow Times, and residents informed of changes by letter/ plans of the proposed scheme to be implemented, this is a legal/ formal consultation where anybody may object. It is therefore important that we know your views as we will not assume anything if we do not receive your questionnaire.

It is important that you understand if controls are removed they will not be reinstated at a later date.

We need your views on how these proposals will affect you and if you are in favour of parking controls being removed from Oxleay Road. We are happy to remove the existing controls if this is what the majority of residents wish.

The Proposals

We are seeking your views on the following proposals:

- To remove all parking controls within Oxleay Road including waiting restrictions (single yellow lines) and resident permit bays with the exception of double yellow lines at junctions which are required on safety grounds.
- Upgrading of existing single yellow line restrictions to double yellow lines ('No Waiting At Any Time') at the junctions of Oxleay Road/ Rayners Lane and Oxleay Road/ Alexandra Avenue. These are based on safety grounds and will be implemented but your comments may allow us to make small changes. If you have comments based on the double yellow line proposals we would like to hear your views.

This stage of the consultation process

To help you make your decision, we have provided the following items:

- A detailed plan showing the proposals indicating the area where we are consulting residents.
- A questionnaire where you can add your comments on the proposals. (Please complete and return to us in the supplied pre paid envelope).
- · A parking booklet titled 'Parking Can We Help You', which outlines the advantages and disadvantages of Controlled Parking Zones to help you make your decision.

The detailed plan will also available for inspection in the reception area at the Council Civic Centre on Station Road, Harrow, during the consultation period. Officers will be available should you wish to discuss the scheme proposals.

We need your views to assist us in making the right decision. This is your opportunity to provide comments with your views.

We wish to make sure that everyone who may be affected by these proposals knows what is happening and has the opportunity to let us know what they think.

Please complete the enclosed questionnaire and return it in the attached reply paid envelope, to reach us by 26th July 2010.

What happens next?

We will analyse your response to see what support there is for Oxleay Road to be removed from the Rayners Lane Controlled Parking Zone L. The consultation results and recommended proposals based on what you say will be reported to the Portfolio Holder (the elected councillor responsible for making transport decisions). The views of residents which will remain anonymous will be available on the council's website: www.harrow.gov.uk under the 'Transport and Streets' tab in late August.

We will inform you of Portfolio Holder decision of this consultation by leaflet. If the decision is to remove parking restrictions we will advertise the revised proposals by placing notices on street lamp columns and in a local paper (Harrow Times) which will also explain where the plans can be seen. This will give people a final chance to comment on the scheme or object if they wish.
