

## Bernays Close Proposed Relocation of Permit Bay Stanmore Controlled Parking Zone B Review





The original Stanmore Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) B was introduced a number of years ago with an hour of control from 3pm - 4pm Monday to Friday to prevent all day parking by non residents. Since introducing the parking controls we have had requests from residents to make alterations to the current design/ controls, following such requests we are now consulting residents to determine their views.

Once a CPZ has been 'Live' for a period of time it is subject to a review, this is to determine how the controls are working or if any amendments/ changes are required to the existing restrictions.



### Linden Close - Proposed Removal of Controls

### Linden Close - Proposed Removal of Controls

#### What is this about?

The original Stanmore Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) B was introduced a number of years ago with an hour of control from 3pm - 4pm to prevent all day commuter parking for Stanmore Station. Following formal requests in June 2008 after a consultation to extend the Stanmore CPZ due to the opening of Wembley Stadium and increase in commuter parking around Stanmore Station, parking controls were introduced to Linden Close.

After any CPZ is introduced into an area it is subject to a review, this is to determine how the controls are working or if any amendments/ changes are required to the existing restrictions.

The Council has received requests from residents of Linden Close for controls to be removed and for Linden Close to not be included in the Stanmore Controlled Parking Zone B.

This consultation is to find out the views of residents and the council will act on a majority decision.

It is to be noted that if controls are removed they will not be reinstated at a later date.

We need your views on how these proposals will affect you and if you are in favour of parking controls being removed from Linden Close.

#### **Our Proposals**

We are seeking your views on the following proposals:

- To remove all parking controls within Linden Close including waiting restrictions and resident permit bays.
