## **Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions**

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol:

- 1 No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
  - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b) (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
- 2. Every supply or sale of alcohol made under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises exhibition of films:

- (1) The admission of persons under the age of 18 years to exhibitions of films must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification, except where condition 2 applies.
- (2) The admission of persons under the age of 18 years to exhibitions of films must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the relevant licensing authority regarding the film in question

Mandatory condition where licence requires door supervision:

Where one or more individuals are required to be at the premises to carry out a security activity, such individual(s) must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.





#### **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule**

- 1. CCTV is installed and will be operated and maintained in accordance with the reasonable specification of the Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer: CCTV images will be securely stored, kept for a minimum of 31 days and made available to officers of the police or local authority upon request.
- 2. A central station monitored alarm system is installed and will be maintained and operated in accordance with the reasonable specification of the Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer.
- 3. All fire safety equipment will be operated and maintained according to Fire Brigade guidelines.
- 4. Fire exits are clearly signed and will be kept clear of obstruction at all times.
- 5. Notices will be clearly displayed at all exits requesting that patrons respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and area quietly.
- 6. No music or amplified sound will be audible at the boundary of neighbouring residential properties so as to give rise to nuisance.
- 7. No children will be permitted on the premises unless accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult.
- 8. The premises will operate a 'Challenge 21' policy, whereby any person wishing to purchase alcohol and who appears to be under 21 years of age will be asked to provide proof (i.e. passport, driver's licence or some other such form of accredited photo identification) that they are over the age of 18 years. Notices will be displayed advising that this policy is in operation and a record of refusals of sale will be kept.
- 9. All music (live or amplified) only to be played inside the premises.
