

There were 131 children looked after in Harrow on 31 August 2010.


The bar chart below shows the number of children looked after by quarters from 2006.




Of these 131, 14 looked after children are allocated to the Children with Disabilities Team.

2) CLA Age and Gender Breakdown




3) CLA Age and Ethnicity Breakdown







5) CLA by Ethnicity & Gender





The breakdown of category of need as recorded when a child becomes looked after.







There were 191 children who have a Child Protection Plan in Harrow on 31 August 2010.


The bar chart below shows the number of children with Child Protection Plans by quarters since 2006








