Harrow Strategic Partnership Governance Handbook 18th October 2010

Introduction

The governance handbook was rewritten to strengthen the decision making process across the Harrow Strategic Partnership, confirm the powers of the Harrow Strategic Partnership to allocate funding and clarify the role and responsibilities of members.

The updated Governance handbook was presented to the Partnership Board on the 15th June for discussion. Comments were invited from the Board members by the 15th September with the intention of then adopting the handbook at the next Partnership Board meeting.

As requested a copy of the governance handbook, which included track changes was circulated after the meeting to all members.

No further comments or additions were received on the document.

Proposed Action

It is proposed that the Partnership Board adopts the new governance handbook.

Decision Making Group

The following governance handbook extracts set out the requirements for the urgent decision making sub group.

- 23.23. At each Annual General Meeting no less than 4 cross agency Partnership Board members plus the chair will be nominated to form a decision sub group of the Partnership Board. The remit of the decision sub group is to discuss and make decisions on behalf of the Partnership Board when a decision is required outside of the meeting timetable.
- 23.24. The decision sub group can only be used if the Partnership Board has agreed to utilise the group for the specific decision beforehand.
- 23.25. The sub group may make decisions via a virtual meeting.
- 23.26. The sub group is required to be quorum for the decision to be made. The quorum shall be 4 of the appointed membership.
