





Area description / Overview




Harrow has a wealth of green infrastructure resources. It has substantial areas of accessible green belt along its northern boundary.

Its residential suburban streets are largely tree-lined, many with wide pavements, green verges and little traffic.

There are many mature well maintained public parks, sports fields and well kept allotments.

The Borough has access to three rivers, the Brent, Colne and Crane .

Area description / Green Space Networks




Harrow's green spaces does not currently read as a network.

Suburban street patterns can be disorientating, and many green spaces are hidden from view.

There are few linking walks or routes.

Local people may not be aware of, or know how to access open space, except by car.


Area description / Deficiencies



Despite containing a large number of green open spaces, parts of the Borough have been identified as deficient in public parks/open space.

This is due partly to restricted access to private land, and also to severance by roads and railway lines.

Area description / Nature conservation



Harrow's public open spaces have relatively limited ecological diversity compared with other boroughs - much of the public open space is given over to amenity grassland.

Streams are pushed to the margins of green spaces or contained in concrete channels, with limited wetland and riparian flora or fauna.

Street trees have been selected in many cases for ornamental rather than ecological value.

Biodiversity works and path network along Edgware Brook and in adjacent open spaces.




