
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1) Safety of Vulnerable Children (Children Looked After)


There were 133 children looked after in Harrow on 30 November 2010.

The bar chart below shows the number of children looked after by guarters from 2006.




There are an additional 24 children receiving respite care / short term breaks (these are not included in the 133 looked after children).













The bar chart below shows the number of children with Child Protection Plans by quarters since 2006












